Measurement Committee notice #1

Competitors are reminded to the Offshore Special Regulation rule 3.14.1(i) regarding the lifelines as follows:

*When a deflecting force of **4 kg** is applied to a lifeline at the mid-point of the longest span between supports that are aft of the mast, the deflection shall not exceed:*

- (i) **50 mm** for an upper or single lifeline*
- (ii) **120 mm** for an intermediate lifeline*

Deflection is measured from the straight line connecting the intersections of the lifelines with adjacent stanchions.

Lifeline tension will be checked during the on-the-water post-race measurement checks, but can also be checked any time during the event.
