# NOTICE OF RACE

With Amendment No. 1

# 1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Neither spinnakers nor double headsails are permitted in the Leukemia Cruising Class. Entrants with racing experience are not permitted in the Leukemia Class. Experienced racers shall participate in other classes.
- 1.3 PHRF N competitors only may use double headsails.

# 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

PHRF A0	PHRF N	J/80	CRCA Racer/Cruiser
PHRF A1	Alerion Express 28	J/30	CRCA True Cruiser
PHRF A2	Cal 25	J/35	Multihull A
PHRF B	Harbor 20	J/105	Multihull B
PHRF C	J/70	CRCA Pocket Cruiser	Leukemia Cruising Class

- Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Thursday, 02 June 2016.
- 2.3 The fee is \$150 and includes one (1) **All-Inclusive** package to the Rock the Dock Party. Entries must be received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 02 June 2016. Note that \$100 of the \$150 entry fee will go directly to the Maryland Chapter of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.
- 2.4 Proceeds from entry fees will be donated to the Maryland Chapter of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. Therefore, refunds will not be granted for cancelled registrations.

#### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than 2000 hours on Wednesday, 01 June 2016, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

#### 5 VENUE

- 5.1 Racing will be on the Severn River and on the adjacent waters of the Chesapeake Bay.
- 5.2 A post-race party and awards presentation will be held at the EYC clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.

#### 6 COURSES

- 6.1 The Harbor 20 class will sail a Severn River course.
- The CRCA Pocket Cruiser, Racer/Cruiser, and True Cruiser classes, Leukemia Cruising Class, PHRF N, and Multihull classes will sail courses using CBYRA Region 3 Annapolis Area standard racing marks.
- 6.3 All other classes will sail drop mark courses as shown in the Sailing Instructions.

### 7 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the Cruising One Design, one-design, and Leukemia classes only, RRS 44.1 is changed so that when a rule of Part 2 is broken outside the zone at a mark, and there is no injury or damage, and no significant advantage is gained, the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. This changes RRS 44.1.

#### 8 SCORING

RRS Appendix A4, the Low Point System, will apply. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

#### 9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes in each class will be given as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place for six (6) or more entries;
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place for seven (7) or more entries.
- 9.2 Additional prizes will be awarded as described in NoR 12, Additional Information.

# 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in Hospice Cup entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4. The organizing authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

#### 11 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

### 12 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 12.1 This is a Clean Regatta; all competitors are encouraged not to use disposable water bottles. Racers should refrain from throwing trash in the water and recycle all appropriate items.

What is Leukemia Cup? The Leukemia Cup Regatta is designed to raise funds for research to cure blood related cancers like leukemia and lymphoma. It has raised over \$50 million dollars since it began in Annapolis in 1992. In 2014, over 10,000 sailors around the country took part in raising funds and sailing for this important cause. It is a CBYRA-sanctioned regatta held annually to benefit The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, Maryland Chapter. The regatta will be held in Annapolis, hosted by Eastport Yacht Club and Annapolis Yacht Club, and will offer racing for a variety of classes of boats on the Chesapeake Bay. Sailors from all over the Bay will have an opportunity to join the event.

Where Does the Money Go? In 2015, The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society provided \$67.2 million to researchers around the world, including five researchers and institutions in Maryland including Johns Hopkins. Funds raised in by this event will stay in Maryland for local programs of research, patient aid, education, and to increase the awareness in the mission to cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease, myeloma, and improve the quality of life of patients and their families.
