RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *J/30 Class Rules* J/30 Class Rule 5.14.1 (Sailing Weight), requiring hull draft marks is waived; sailing weight may be determined by measurement.

In addition to meeting the crew weight limit, boats must sail with the same number of crew in each race. Only crew substitutions declared by name and sailing date at registration will be permitted, except in case of illness, accident or other special circumstance, which will require written approval of the protest committee. Each boat must be equipped with a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 78. Violations of Class Rules, or of rules other than Part 2 of the RRS, will be penalized at the discretion of the protest committee, and may be less than disqualification. This changes rule 64.1.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all J/30s conforming to J/30 Class Rules. Competitors must meet all ownership, class membership, and measurement requirements; submit an official entry form and pay all event fees before becoming official competitors.

LOANER BOATS

A limited number of loaner boats will be available according to district qualification procedures. A loaner boat will automatically be offered to the 2013 J/30 North American Champion, provided they meet the eligibility requirements. Loaner boat insurance is provided by the J/30 Class at no additional expense to the competitors. A security deposit covering the \$250. deductible expense will be required. This deposit will be returned at the end of the regatta, provided there is no insurance claim.

ENTRIES

Entry form and fee must be completed no later than August 22 to avoid the Late Fee. Entry form must be completed online at the regatta website.

Please submit your entry form ASAP! You may pay the entry fee later if you wish.

Payment of entry fee of \$575 must be made on the regatta website. Late entries may be accepted through September 11. The fee for late entry is \$100, resulting in a \$675 regatta fee.

Entry Fees include: Boat entry and all social events for the skipper and six crewmembers. Additional social packages may be purchased in advance or at registration for \$50. Entry includes continental breakfast each race day, dinners for skipper and crew Friday and Saturday, plus beer, snacks and soft beverages after racing, and t-shirts for 7.

REGISTRATION

Each boat owner or owner's representative must complete registration at CPYC between 0900 and 1700 on Thursday, September 11 including: (i) completion of entry form, waiver, and payment of all fees; (ii) completion of inspection and delivery of Certificate of Measurement; and (iii) boat in the water and rigged. Skipper and crew weigh-in and signed liability waivers must be completed by 0900 on Friday.

INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. An **unofficial** copy of the Sailing Instructions will also be posted at the regatta website after September 1.

INSPECTION & MEASUREMENT

Boats: Boats shall be presented for measurement during the registration period at CPYC's hoist area or as arranged with the Measurement Committee.

Sails: Sail certification will be conducted during measurement, or as arranged with the Measurement Committee.

Crew: All crewmembers sailing in the regatta must sign the Regatta Liability Waiver and weigh in prior to sailing.

COURSES

The racing area will be located on Long Island Sound southeast of Westport, CT. Courses will be windward/leeward.

PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T, Sections A, B, and D will be used, and will be posted on the Notice Board.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, changed such that when fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Nine races are scheduled. One race must be completed to constitute a championship.

PRIZES

Individual race and series prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries. Overall prizes awarded by the J/30 Class Association will be half hull models.

SUPPORT BOATS

Support and spectator boats will be required to register and obtain flags for display while near the race course.

HAUL-OUT RESTRICTION

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the protest committee.

MERCHANDISE

Regatta merchandise may be ordered on the regatta website.

DIRECTIONS (From North and South)

Connecticut Turnpike (I-95) to exit 17 (Westport). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Route 136. Go about 1 mile on Route 136. Turn left on Duck Pond Road. Go 0.3 miles, then left on Harbor Road. Follow Harbor Road to the stop sign before one-way bridge. **DO NOT CROSS BRIDGE WITH TRAILER'S OR SUV'S.** Turn right just before bridge onto Canal Road. Go 0.25 miles to the end and turn left onto Cockeone Drive. Take your first left onto Spriteview Avenue and then the first right onto Crossway. This will take you to the club.

*CPYC shares Bluff Point in a residential neighborhood populated by many young children and pedestrians. **Please be mindful of the 15 mph speed limit and obey all stop signs on Saugatuck Island.** The extra minute will make your drive safer, more pleasant and benefit our relations with Island residents.*

I hereby forever and irrevocably waive, release and discharge any and all claims, liability, loss, or damages, including but not limited to claims for property damage, personal injury or death, which I may have or in the future acquire against Cedar Point Yacht Club, its officers, governors, members, employees, volunteers or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in any race or other activity sponsored or undertaken by any of them, even though such liability may arise out of their negligence or carelessness. I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailboat racing, and that participants in sailboat racing occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence, and I knowingly assume all of the risks of sailboat racing. I agree that this waiver is binding on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns.

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I agree to be bound by The Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event.
