- 1. MANAGEMENT. Whidbey Island Race Week will be conducted by Clear Ahead Marine Productions which will have the authority to reject any entry before racing starts; interpret the rules and conditions of the race; and decide any protests. The fleet shall be divided into handicap or one design classes according to rating and other factors at the discretion of Clear Ahead Marine Productions
- 2. ELIGIBILITY. Race Week is open to cruising/racing yachts 19 to 75 feet LOA that:
- A. Are self-righting, properly rigged and ballasted and fully seaworthy. A provision will be made for a multi-hull class start provided there are at least 6 multi-hull yachts entered. Each yacht shall carry an operating VHF radio.
- B. Conform to the current PIYA Regulations Governing Minimum Equipment and Accommodation Standards for Category III.
- C. Have a valid PHRF NW rating, or belong to a one-design class with sufficient boats registered to form a class (See *Rating* and *Classes, section 4, paragraph B*)
- 3. RULES. The rules governing Whidbey Island Race Week will be:
- A. The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016.
- B. For PHRF-rated boats, The 2014 Regulations of PHRF NW (published with their 2014 roster), and for boats racing in a one-design class, their class rules.
- C. This Race Notice, and The Sailing Instructions, including any amendments
- D. US Sailing Prescription to RRS 64.3 (b) will not apply
- E. In the case of a conflict between this NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- **4. RATING AND CLASSES**. It is the responsibility of each entrant to have a valid rating or one design certificate on file with Clear Ahead Marine Productions.
- A. All yachts in the PHRF Class must have a current PHRF-NW valid speed potential rating and certificate. Non PHRF-NW members may contact PHRF-NW at PHRF Northwest Business Office, PO Box 489, Gig Harbor, WA 98335; (253) 857-8858, FAX 425-962-8729; E-mail <a href="mailto:phrfnw@gmail.com">phrfnw@gmail.com</a>. A/R Forms, applications and other information are available at the PHRF NW Web site, <a href="mailto:www.phrf-nw.org">www.phrf-nw.org</a>.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that the data relative to the entered yacht held in the PHRF-NW data bank is current and correct and that he accepts the published or the temporary PHRF-NW rating for his yacht. Prior to the start of racing, ratings/certificates for all boats of a class or one-design for which there are multiple entries will be reviewed by a PHRF-NW handicapper and a panel of knowledgeable people appointed by Clear Ahead Marine Productions. (Example – two identical boats register with different ratings.) Ratings modified by this process are neither subject to redress (Modifies RRS 62.1) nor subject to appeal (Modifies RRS 70.1). All such rating changes will be posted on the official notice board by 1900 on the Sunday, 20 July 2014.

Clear Ahead Marine Productions assumes the database of PHRF-NW to be correct and will accept no responsibility or obligation arising from errors.

B. One design classes or groups of yachts wishing to level race will be given a start provided there are at least 10 yachts entered. Each yacht in a one-design class must comply with Class Rules and other requirements of this event.

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- C. Boats with a youth sailor under 18 but not including 18 years of age will receive a 3 second credit to your rating. Boats with over 8 crew must have two youth sailors to receive this credit. Crew Credit form must be filled out at Race Headquarters Sunday 20, 2014. This will include name of youth sailor, age, and signature of skipper. You must have a youth sailor(s) on board every day for all races to qualify for this credit. Substitutions are allowed as long as the form is updated by 10:30 am at Race Headquarters the day of the race. If youth(s) racer is missing on any day. All results will be recalculated with the credit removed.
- **5. IDENTIFICATION**. Race Week Identification will be required for each person participating in any of the many Race Week activities. Skippers should order one for themselves and each person on their crew or guest list when entering (\$65). Additional guest Identifications will be available at Race Week Headquarters (\$75) but only Skippers may purchase them.
- 6. MOORAGE. Race Week Moorage is available at the Oak Harbor Marina, which has two-thousand feet of guest floats inside the breakwater. NOTE: Race Week Entry does not include moorage. For reservations and rates contact the Oak Harbor Marina, 865 SE Barrington Drive, Oak Harbor, WA, 98277, (360) 279-4575, Fax (360) 240-0603, Email slee@oakharbor.org, http://www.whidbey.net/ohmarina. Yachts may anchor at no charge outside the breakwater. Oak Harbor is not a Port Of Entry. Canadian vessels should clear customs at Friday Harbor, Anacortes, Bellingham, or any other Port of Entry.

#### 7. EVENTS

**Sunday, July 20 Registration-1200-1700:** Distribution of Identifications, Race Kits, Entry List and Special Instructions, Skippers Meeting Oak Harbor Yacht Club at 1700.

Sunday, July 20 Opening Reception 1800 - 2000

**Daily, July 21-25-Activities-0800-1030:** Shore side activities such as sailing clinics and product demonstrations for Race Week participants with Identifications. Watch the official website for updates

**Daily, July 21-25-Racing-Scheduled Start 12:00 Racing** in Crescent Harbor - Penn Cove - Saratoga Passage. **Daily, July 21-25-Parties-1800-2000 (OR AFTER RACING!):** Evening social gatherings and award presentations with complimentary beverages and entertainment for Race Week participants with Identifications.

- **8. AWARDS**. Race Week class awards will be presented daily for first, second and third place each day. Overall awards based on the cumulative scores for the week will be awarded to first, second, and third yachts in each class after the final race. In addition, special recognition will be given to the outstanding competitors.
- **9. ENTRY PROCEDURE.** Please complete and mail an Entry Form with appropriate rating certificate and fees as soon as possible. Email Confirmation will be sent upon receipt.
- A. Race Week Program, including Sailing Instructions, will be presented to each accepted entry at registration.
- B. The regatta will be limited to the first 175 entries. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS LIMIT IS REACHED.
- C. Entry closing will be July 15, 2014 or when the Limit has been reached.
- E. By submitting an entry each owner/skipper certifies that they have read and accept the Conditions of Whidbey Island Race Week and that the current and valid measurement certificate submitted with entry will be the rating application to the yacht at the start and throughout the series.
- F. Any Completed Registration Postmarked by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014 will receive ONE FREE EVENT IDENTIFICATION PASS.
- G. Any Completed Registration Postmarked by March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014 will receive \$50 off entry fee and One Free Event ID Pass.
- H. Postmark dates will be strictly enforce

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**10. FEES.** Entry Fee and Identification Fee are completely separate from Moorage Fees.

Entry Fee for Yacht (does not include ID)

For all entries received on or before June 15th:

Up to 28 feet LOA \$400 US Funds.
29 to 35 feet LOA \$450 US Funds.
36 to 40 feet LOA \$500 US Funds.
Greater than 41 feet LOA \$550 US Funds.

Advertising Fee (if applicable) - \$100 US Funds (For example - Sails or Hulls with advertising) Identification Fee- Skipper/Crew/Guest-\$65 US Funds (\$75 at Event) Identification Fee-Junior under 21-\$20.00 US Funds (\$25 at Event)

The **ADVERTISING FEE** is applicable to all boats that wish to comply with ISAF Category C, and will be applied to Race Week News or Program print advertising if desired. All boats not paying the advertising fee must comply with ISAF Category A. Boats desiring to advertise in the Race Week News or Program contact Clear Ahead Marine Productions for a rate sheet.

The ID Bracelet gives access to the site and is not a drink ticket. It is a fee to offset the cost of all activities at the site. These activities include live music, trophies, seminars, video, food and beverages. Underage crew and guests are encouraged to take part in the activities and will receive a different ID than adults.

Cancellations received by June 15, 2014 will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100. Entry Fee will not be returned after this date.

- **11. ACCOMMODATIONS**. Race Week participants desiring shore side accommodations information should contact the Greater Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce, Oak Harbor, WA 98277, (360) 675-3535 or view the website <a href="https://www.whidbeyislandraceweek.com">www.whidbeyislandraceweek.com</a> under lodging.
- **12. CAMPING –** Camping at the Navy Base is still available. Unfortunately the costs involved to have free camping have changed. Between Naval administrative charges, Bathrooms and Fencing costs we have to charge a nominal fee for camping this year. \$25 per tent and \$40 per RV for the week. Tent and RV passes can be purchased at Race Head Quarters.
- **13. TRANSPORTATION**. Whidbey Island is accessible by land, sea and air via either private or public conveyances. Deception-Pass Bridge and Washington State ferries provide four alternative highway routes to the island. Saratoga Passage, Deception Pass and the Swinomish Channel offer three different water approaches.
