HOSPICE TURKEY SHOOT REGATTA

October 3-5, 2014



Rappahannock River Yacht Club Organizing Authority

- 1. Rules:** The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2. Eligibility:** Open to all mono-hull sailboats whose design is 25 years old or older and at least 18 feet long. USCG approved life vest required to be worn from start to finish to race single-handed.
- 3. Format/Ratings:**
 - 3.1** The regatta will consist of a buoy race on Saturday and a Pursuit race on Sunday.
 - 3.2** Boats without a current valid PHRF of the Chesapeake certificate will be assigned a rating by the Regatta Committee. Boats without current certificates are asked to complete a HTSR Rating Application form. Once this form has been submitted, it will not need to be submitted in future years. This rating is not subject to appeal, outside of the Turkey Shoot Rating committee. The committee will make every effort to assure fair ratings. The committee will attempt to honor Hospice Turkey Shoot Regatta ratings from previous regattas.
 - 3.3** Spinnaker/Non-Spinnaker – Boats may sail with or without spinnakers. Boats electing to fly spinnaker must so indicate on their Entry Form or at Registration on Friday, October 3, no later than 2000 hours. Boats making NO spinnaker declaration may not fly a spinnaker. Boats declaring spinnaker will be given a rating penalty of 21 seconds/mile for both days.
 - 3.4** Boats will be assigned to a division based on their rating before the spinnaker penalty is applied.
- 4. Divisions:** Ten Divisions are planned to include One Design Division(s), if there is a minimum of 5 OD Boats per Division. Boats will be placed in Divisions based on ratings and type of boat.
- 5. Entry and Fee:** Eligible boats may enter by registering online at Yacht

Scoring: www.yachtscoring.com or on the approved entry form and received no later than 1600 September 1, 2014. Late entries will be accepted until day of regatta with late fee.

Fee for entries received before September 1, 2014 is \$60

Fee for entries received after September 1, 2014 is \$70

6- Schedules: All on-shore events will be at the Event Tent at the end of Carter's Creek Road, at Rappahannock Yachts.

Friday, October 3

Sunday, October 5

Free Water Taxi available: 0630 to 1000 and 1600 to 1800 (call on channel 13)

- **0700 to 0815:** Competitors Breakfast (complimentary for Captain and Crew)
- **0830:** Mandatory Skippers Meeting in event tent
- **1000:** Warning Signal (Pursuit Race)
- **1430:** – Time Limit
- An Awards Ceremony will be held in the event tent as soon as results for the regatta series are available. Overall series and Sunday Race Standings will be posted in the event tent as soon as possible.

7. Division Assignment: Skippers who would like to race against another specific boat (s) such as from the same yacht club, same marina, just a friendly competitor, or from a One Design Fleet can request that, no later than one week before the regatta, September 27, 2014. The Turkey Shoot Organizing Authority will try to honor your request. This could also apply to a yacht club/marina where the boats wish to also award their champion within the Turkey Shoot Regatta. Email or call one of the Organizing Authority Officers listed in Paragraph 14 below.

8. Sailing Instruction: will be available at Yachtscoring.com by September 26, 2014 and will also be in the Skipper's Packet at Registration.

9. Courses: Saturday will consist of a triangle and/or windward-leeward drop mark course. Saturday, Divisions will be placed into Fleet A and Fleet B, based on rating, with the latter racing a shorter course. Sunday will consist of a pursuit race. Racing will be held in the Rappahannock River between the Norris Bridge and Towles Point.

10. Scoring: The Low Point scoring system, Rule A2, will apply. Saturday's race scoring will be by corrected time finish within each Division. Sunday's race scoring will be by order of finish within each Division. The overall winner, the Division winner with the lowest series score (with a tie breaker, if required, of finish position in Sunday's Pursuit Race), will have their name engraved on the Virginia Spirit Cup and also receive a keeper trophy from AGA Correa Marine Jewelers.

11. Haul-Out Restrictions: Boats must be in the water by 1000 hours on Saturday, October 4. During the regatta yachts may only be hauled with written permission of the Race Committee.

12. Radios: Each boat shall have a working VHF radio. The Race Committee will use VHF Channel 72 to make courtesy announcements regarding general information, starting sequence, and boats that are over early.

13. Berthing: Anchorage and free water taxi service will be available in Carter's Creek and its tributaries. A limited number of slips are available at:
