NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Viper 640 International Class Rules shall apply.
- 1.3 The notation "[DP]" in a rule in this Notice of Race (NoR) means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification.
- 1.4 The notation "[NP]" in a rule in this NoR means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Viper 640 Regatta is open to all Viper 640 boats sailing in compliance with the current Viper 640 International Class Rules.
- 2.2 Registration will be available online no later than Saturday, 14 December 2019, at the Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) website http://eastportyc.org/viper640.

3 FEES

The fee is:

- \$150 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 24 April 2020.
- \$200 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 24 April 2020, but before 1200 hours on Friday, 01 May 2020.

4.2 A maximum of eight (8) races are scheduled, of which two (2) shall be completed to constitute a series.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

[NP] The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than 2000 hours on Saturday, 25 April 2020, and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at http://eastportyc.org/viper640.

6 VENUE

Racing area will be on the Chesapeake Bay, in the vicinity of the mouth of the Severn River.

7 COURSES

Competitors will sail windward/leeward drop mark courses as shown in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, will apply, as further specified in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 RRS Appendix A4, the Low Point System, will apply.
- 9.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores if five (5) or fewer races are completed. One (1) race score will be excluded if six (6) or more races are completed.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

[DP] [NP] Competitors shall have and monitor a working VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 9, 13, 16, and 73.

11 PRIZES

- Overall prizes will be presented at an post-race social at EYC following the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 03 May 2020, as follows.
 - 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place awards;
 - 4th Place award, provided there are sixteen (16) or more entries;
 - 5th Place award, provided there are twenty (20) or more entries.
- 11.2 Boats that compete in each of the following three (3) events Viper 640 Mid-Atlantic Championship, Annapolis NOOD, and Southern Bay Race Week will be eligible for the Viper 640 Chesapeake Bay Championship Trophy, to be awarded at Southern Bay Race Week. The final standings will be based on high point scoring across all three events.
- 11.3 Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organizing Authority (OA).

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Boats participate in the Viper 640 Mid-Atlantic Championship entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The OA will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

13 INSURANCE

[DP] [NP] Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
