NOTICE OF RACE

REV. 1: 5-21-21

Organizing Authority: The 2021 Thistle National Championship Regatta is organized by the Thistle Class Association (TCA) in conjunction with the Cleveland Yachting Club (CYC).

The notation (NP) in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1 (a).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescription to RRS63.2 will not apply.
- 1.3 Racing Rule 60.1 (a) is changed to add: Boats failing to display required advertising may not be protested by another boat.
- 1.4 Other racing rules may be changed. These changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5 Alcohol consumption by persons under 21 years of age, the use of illegal substances and the abuse of prescription-only drugs shall be considered "misconduct" for the purposes of RRS 69.
- 1.6 It is each skipper's responsibility to ensure they and their crew adhere to all state and county health regulations. [NP]

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at www.thistlenationals2021.com, and the CYC registration desk no later than Friday July 30, 2021 at 1400 hrs. In order to conduct a more green regatta, printed paper copies of the SI's will only be available upon request.

3. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The RC may transmit via VHF radio information concerning safety, OCS boats, and general information to assist in the management of the event. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make or receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to boats of the TCA that are active members in good standing with a valid measurement certificate and have sailed the required qualifying event(s) to be eligible to compete in Thistle Nationals, as outlined in the Bylaws of the TCA, and as amended by the Thistle Class Governing Board in relation to the Covid-19 global pandemic. Registration is limited to the first 125 boats registered.
- 4.2 The Organizing Authority will require certain protocols to be followed in light of the Covid-19 global pandemic. Participants, including non-sailing attendees, shall show proof of Covid-19 vaccination or provide a negative Covid-19 test result conducted no more than 48 hours prior to arrival at CYC. This protocol is subject to change at any time based on State of Ohio guidelines and /or current conditions. Waivers to this protocol will be considered by The Cleveland Yachting Club medical corps committee on a case-by-case basis. Waiver requests should be submitted to brantmrussell@gmail.com. [NP]
- 4.3 No competitor may be paid to sail in this event, and private coaching is not allowed in this event, as per TCA Bylaw Article IX, Section 3.
- 4.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration and paying regatta fees by May 1, 2021. No entry will be accepted after July 15 without written permission from the Regatta Chairman and National Race Committee.
- 4.5 Online registration can be found at www.thistlenationals2021.com.
- 4.6 Competitors must complete on-site registration and the measurement process during times specified in the schedule; any extension requires written permission from the Regatta Chairman and National Race Committee.

5. FEES

- 5.1 Early Registration Fees: \$475 inclusive of \$40 TCA Trophy Fee and Friday awards dinner for a crew of 3, for registrations completed and paid before May 1, 2021. Those entries which become eligible via the wait list, will have 5 days to complete and pay registration fees from the date notified they have been moved from the wait list to the active entry list. Late entries will be accepted with a \$100 late fee between June 1 and July 15.
- 5.2 Registration fees include three tickets to the opening and closing ceremonies.
- 5.3 A special Early Registration food package is available until May 31 for \$100 which provides dinners on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday for a crew of 3 (Yes, \$100 includes tickets for the crew of 3!)
- 5.4 Registration fees are fully refundable (less any credit card transaction fees) until June 15, and partially refundable (less 20%) until July 15. No refunds after July 15. Should the regatta be canceled due to Covid-19 global pandemic, all registration and meal fees will be refunded (less PayPal fees).
- 5.5 Skippers 26 years old and under may apply for a registration fee refund by contacting VP Growth and Promotions, Alison Gillum (agillum915@gmail.com) Applications should be sent in no later than June 15 and should include birthdate. Please indicate whether sailing National Championship, Junior Nationals or both. Details of reimbursement will be available upon application.
- 5.6 Dinner packages will be available after June 1 for \$70 per person to include the Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday dinners. Kids under 8 eat free. Ages 9-15 are half off at \$35 per person for dinners and banquet.
- 5.7 Additional Trophy Banquet Tickets are Available for \$55 per person.

6. ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Boats may be required to display advertising which will be supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA).

7. PRACTICE RACE, QUALIFYING SERIES, AND FINAL SERIES.

- 7.1 In the practice race, the fleet will race in one Division. The Practice Race will also serve as the “**75th Anniversary Race**” open to any Thistle regardless of registration for the National Championship Races. A separate registration for the 75th Anniversary Race will be available at www.thistlenationals2021.com for those not sailing in the National Championship Regatta (sign up using the Women’s/Juniors registration link).
- 7.2 The regatta will consist of a qualifying series and a final series.
- 7.3 In the qualifying series (Races 1-3), the fleet will be split into four (4) groups as per TCA Bylaw Article III, Section 11. Each group will race the other groups once. Two groups will comprise a Division for a race.
- 7.4 In the final series (Races 4-7), the fleet will be divided into Championship and President’s Divisions in accordance with TCA Bylaw Article XIII, Section 13(a) based on their finishing position in the qualifying series. Separate courses will be used for the Championship and Presidents Series.

8. SCHEDULE

8.1 Registration and Measurement

8.3 National Championship Race Series

8.4 The RC may adjust the race schedule to suit weather conditions.

8.5 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1530 for any race in the Championship Division.

9. MEASUREMENT

- 9.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.
- 9.2 Boat, equipment, and sails will be measured, inspected and may be spot-checked as specified in the TCA rules, RRS or the Sailing Instructions. Specific items to be measured at registration will be found on the measurement forms posted at www.thistlenationals2021.com.

- 10.2 Races will be sailed on Lake Erie approximately 2.0 nautical miles (NM) northwest of CYC.
- 10.3 Housing: Note that camping of any form is not allowed on CYC property. Local hotel information will be available at www.thistlenationals2021.com. A limited amount of private housing will be available. Send an email to Tom Sessions at thistlenationals2021@gmail.com or use the Hotels and Housing tab on the website.

11. THE COURSES

- 11.1 The courses will be in accordance with the TCA Bylaws, section 7. A separate course will be used for the President's Division.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.1 A boat that takes a penalty or retires under RRS 44 shall sign the acknowledgement form posted in the vicinity of the official notice board within the protest time limit.
- 12.2 The right of appeal from a protest committee decision is denied as provided in RRS 70.5 (a) for the qualifying series only. Competitors may appeal decisions of the protest committee in the Championship Series. US Sailing's permission has been granted. If the requirements shown on <https://www.ussailing.org/competition/rules-officiating/appeal/no-appeal-rule-70-5-procedures/> are not met, the decisions of the protest committee may be appealed.

13. SCORING

- 13.1 The series scores for boats in the Championship Division will be the total of all their race scores, including the Qualifying Races, with no races excluded.
- 13.2 The series scores for boats in the President's Division will be the total of their race scores, excluding the Qualifying Races.
- 13.3 Four (4) races inclusive of the Qualifying Races are required to be completed to constitute a series for the Championship Division.
- 13.4 One (1) race exclusive of the Qualifying Races is required to be completed to constitute a series for the President's Division.
- 13.5 The divisional assignments will be based on the scores for races 1 to 3 after protest and redress hearings for those races have concluded. Changes to the scores in the first three races after racing has commenced in the final series shall not constitute grounds for granting redress with regard to divisional assignments [This is an addition to RRS 62.1] but they will be factored into the scoring for the event.
- 13.6 Pursuant to RRS 90.3 (e); there shall be no changes to race or series scores resulting from action, including the correction of errors, initiated after 8 AM Wednesday for the Qualifying Series races and after 6 PM on Friday for the Championship and President Series races.

14. SUPPORT BOATS

- 14.1 Support Boats shall be registered and marked with an OA supplied identifier.
- 14.2 Due to limited open berthing spaces, anyone planning on bringing an additional boat of any kind to the event must contact the Regatta Chairman to make arrangements for use of hoists and slips.

15. DRY SAIL AREA

- 15.1 Dry sail spaces will be assigned for all competitors and be available beginning Friday July 30. For arrival before the 30th please contact the Regatta Chairman to make arrangements.

16. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.** Each competitor shall be required to sign a waiver for loss, damage, or injury to persons or property incurred in connection with the Regatta that occurs as a result of a competitor's actions.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum value of \$100,000 USD. Competing teams must show proof of insurance at Registration.

18. AWARDS

- 18.1 The National Championship and "Louis Carron Perpetual Trophy" will be awarded to the winning boat in the Championship Division.
- 18.2 Other awards will be made at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
