Instructions:

- 1. Crew size is at the discretion of the skipper. It's important to practice social distancing onboard your boat and on dock
- 2. Autopilots and powered winches permitted.
- 3. No awards, no socials, no protests. Sail clean and have fun.
- 4. Weather permitting, 4 days of racing, Sun June 28-Weds July 1.
- 5. Pursuit start begins at 12:00 PM. The starting line is from a marker on shore at the fishing pier to a buoy offshore. We're targeting a 3-4 hr race daily.
- 6. Monitor Channel 72
- 7. Radio call skippers meeting daily at 9:30 channel 72.
 - a. Random courses to be announced at skippers meeting.
- Register on Yachtscoring.com at <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=11865</u> and choose spinnaker or non-spinnaker class. Enter your LMPHRF DHCP rating or if you don't have one, fill out the boat information as best as you can. Be sure and register by 6pm the day prior to racing. Ratings are non-negotiable. Your starting time will be emailed to you before the first days skippers meeting.
- Finishes will be at fishing dock. There will be someone recording finish times for a couple hours. Be sure and take your own finish time and also not the boat in front and behind you in case there are mixups. The first boats should Call VHF 72 and/or 715-292-4881 approximately 30 min prior to finishing.
- 10. There is no provision to shorten course. Call 715-292-4881 from a phone you can receive text messages on if you withdraw. Leave a message if you do not get a human. We will text or call back to confirm your withdrawal.
- 11. Courses may include govt marks, lat/long coordinates, islands, and/or inflatable marks.
- 12. Colregs and US Coast guard safety requirements apply.
- 13. Scores will be posted on Yachtscoring as soon as possible after the last boat finishes. We're using the TOT scoring method.
- 14. This event is not an official WYC/AIS race. It is being organized by local sailors.
- 15. We are asking skippers to make in liew of a race fee, a \$100 donation of which the net proceeds (deducting \$10 yachtscoring fee and credit card fees) will be donated to a local Bayfield non-profit.
- 16. Everyone must have fun.
