

## **Amendment #4 to the Sailing Instructions**

- A.) In Section 5.2 (RACING SCHEDULE) Wednesday 2/3 is changed to:  
1200 – First Warning. 1 bouy race scheduled, followed immediately by the Havana to Key West Cup. (The finish of the bouy race will be the start of the distance race, as described in new Attachment B.)  
Boats not participating in the Havana bouy race may start by crossing the **distance race** starting line any time between 1300 and 1400 hours.
- B.) In Section 7.2 (STARTING AREAS) the Havana bouy race starting area is changed to:  
23°08.262 N 82°24.671 W  
In Section 7.1 (STARTING AREAS) Havana is changed to:  
In the vicinity of mark R (same as the bouy race finish).
- C.) In Section 11.2 (FINISH) the Havana to Key West race, the finishing line shall be between Key West Entrance Lighted Whistle bouy (KW) and Key West Main Channel Lighted Bell Bouy “2” (red). This finish line may be crossed in either direction. Competitors are to record their finish and turn in finish times to the race committee by 1200 on Saturday 2/7.  
In Section 11.3 (FINISH) remove the word “all” and add new sentence:  
The finishing line for the Havana bouy race shall be between mark R (described below) and the staff/halyard displaying a blue flag on the nearby race committee boat located approximately west of mark R. Cross the finish line from south to north. **NOTE:** The finish will be immediately following a “**buttonhook**” starboard rounding of mark R.
- D.) In Section 9 (START) add new sentence:  
The starting line for the Havana to Key West race will be the finish line for the Havana bouy race as described above. Boats' start times will be their finish times from the bouy race, or the time that they cross the starting line as stated in Section A above.
- E.) Add Attachment B (HAVANA COURSE DESCRIPTION – below).

### **Attachment B**

#### HAVANA COURSE DESCRIPTION

Course:

S – Os – Rs – Gs – Rs – F

Descriptions of marks:

S Yellow Tetrahedron

O Orange Tetrahedron, set at approximately 23°09.090 N 82°22.799 W (550 meters offshore)

R Large red channel marker “2” near the mouth of Havana Harbor

G Green Tetrahedron, set between mark O and the closest point ashore
