

The 105th Admiral Byrd Regatta, October 3rd and 4th 2020 Cambridge Yacht Club in association with CBYRA Cambridge, Maryland

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (RRS), except as any of these are altered by this notice, or by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 2017-2020 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply."

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all One Design classes and all boats with a valid Chesapeake PHRF rating, ORC rating, CRCA rating, or Chesapeake Multihull Assoc. rating. The rating certificate is to be on board at all times.
- 2.2 All One Design classes must comply with their Class Association requirements.
- 2.3 Boats racing in ORC will be scored as a single class.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may register at yachtscoring.com or visit www.cambridgeyachtclub.org.
- 2.5 Entry forms must be received no later than 1200 on Friday October 2nd.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee for the regatta is \$35 for CBYRA members, \$40 for all others, to be received no later than 1200 on Friday, October 2nd.
- 3.2 There shall be no CYC docking fees to race participants beginning 10/1-10/6. Contact the Race Chair or CYC manager to make arrangements in advance.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Saturday, October 3rd includes fleet racing that is open to One Design, PHRF A, B, C & N, Multihull, ORC, and CRCA. Classes with 3 or more entrants will have seperate starts. A Skippers' Meeting will be held at 0900 on 10/3 at CYC. Racing

- starts 1100, 3 races scheduled with drop mark courses. Awards handed out during Saturday night social at CYC. Live music.
- 4.2 Sunday, October 4th will be a distance race from CYC to TAYC and is open to One Design, PHRF A, B, C & N, Multihull, ORC, and CRCA. Classes with 3 or more entrants will have seperate starts. Classes will generally be started in reverse order, with slower classes starting first. First gun is 1000. After race at TAYC.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event websites, listed above, no later than 1700 on 9/25.

6 SCORING

- 6.1 Corrected times for PHRF classes will be calculated using PHRF time-on-time.
- 6.2 Corrected times for ORC classes will be calculated using handicaps provided by the ORC class.
- 6.3 Corrected times for the CRCA classes will be calculated using handicaps provided by the CRCA class.
- 6.4 Corrected times for the Multihull classes will be calculated using handicaps provided by the Multihull class.

7 AWARDS

7.1 Awards will be awarded depending on fleet/class size from online registration.

Awards will be presented at the awards ceremony on Saturday during the after race social.
