



## Notice of Race - Amendment 1 August 13, 2020

### 1 RULES

- 1.3 The Regatta will be run in accordance with the Massachusetts Covid19 Guidance as stated in Workplace Safety and Re-opening Standards for Businesses and Other Entities Providing Youth and Adult Amateur Sports Activities - Phase 3, Step 1, and Marblehead Sailing Guidelines issued by the Marblehead Harbormaster. (DP).
- 1.4 All participants are required to complete a COVID Release Form. This form must be completed for each day of racing and must be maintained on board the boat. All participants must confirm completion of this form at the daily check-in at the signal boat. The form is available in the documents section on the Ted Hood Regatta website at [Yachtscoring.com](http://Yachtscoring.com). (DP)
- 1.5 A boat may not protest another boat for violating NOR 1.3 or 1.4.

- 4) due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Boston, Corinthian and Eastern Yachts Clubs are unable to provide any transient
