AMENDMENT #3 TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

January 25th, 2021

Considering ongoing concerns with the 2020-2021 Covid-19 pandemic, and suspension of US Sailing in person Safety at Seas (SaS) Courses, TPYC is amending the 2021NOR:

Amending 5.2.3 and 6, extending due date of Standard Entry Fees to April 30, 2021

5.2.3 Table of Entry Fees by LOA in feet:

Standard Entry must be Paid by ~~March 1, 2021~~ by **April 30, 2021**

Last Date for Standard Entry fee payment ~~March 1, 2021~~ **Friday, April 30, 2021**

Amending 8.1.3 and 8.1.4, Safety at Sea training requirements:

8.1.3 Crew General Safety Training

At least 60% of a yacht's crew including the Person in Charge and watch captains shall have a valid certificate for:

- a) A US Sailing International Offshore Safety at Sea with Hands-on Training Course, or
- b) The combination of a US Sailing Hands-On Safety at Sea Course and the US Sailing-Offshore Safety at Sea Online Supplemental Course both taken in the same calendar year, or
- c) The combination of a US Sailing Hands-On Safety at Sea Course and a US Sailing On-Line Offshore Safety at Sea course both taken in the same calendar year; or
- d) A World Sailing /(ISAF) Approved Offshore Personal Survival Training Course certificate issued by another country, or
- e) The US Sailing Offshore Safety at Sea Course (in-person), or
- f) The US Sailing [Online Offshore Safety at Sea Course](#)

For double-handed entries both crew members must meet this requirement.

Note: Normally these certificates are valid for five years from course completion. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic US Sailing has extended the validity of certificates with Hands-On training earned in 2015 and 2016 through the end of 2021. With the online course available for recertification, the certificates in e) and f) do not have extended valid dates.
