



1. Rules

1.1. The Kenosha Yacht Club Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as any of these are changed by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1. The Kenosha Yacht Club Regatta will be open to Buccaneer and PHRF boats. Competitors may enter by registering online at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>

3. Fees

- 3.1. Entry Fee will be \$35 per boat. Entry Fee includes:
 - Launching
 - Doughnuts
 - Race fees
 - Saturday Race Party

4. Schedule: August 14, 15, 16

- <u>Friday</u>: Kenosha Yacht Club will be open to receive boats from 10am to midnight
- Saturday: Registration and launching from 8:30am to 9:30am

Skippers Meeting at 9:30am Race 1 Warning Gun at 10:25am More races to immediately follow

No race will start after 3:00pm

Buccaneer hosted party at TBA

Sunday: Launching from 8:30am to 9:30am First Warning Gun at 10:25am More races to immediately follow No race will start after 2:30pm Awards presentation to follow

5. Measurement

5.1. One Design Measurement Certificates should be available for inspection, if so required by class rules.

6. Courses

6.1. The race course will be one mile northeast of the Port of Kenosha on Lake Michigan.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. One race shall constitute a regatta
- 7.2. The Low-Point System of Appendix A shall be used to score each boat.

8. Prizes

8.1. Awards will be given out to the top 3 finishers from each class.
