2021 BCYC Main & Jib Sailing Instructions

Amendment #1

The second paragraph of 'The Start' shall be amended as follows:

Unless otherwise indicated by the Race Committee, the starting mark will be a temporary inflatable buoy 'S' Buoy. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the starting mark.

The first paragraph of 'Courses" shall be amended as follows:


The course to be used will be posted on the white board on the committee boat. The course will be posted with the first mark to be rounded listed first. Unless otherwise noted by the race committee, all marks shall be left to port except 'S' buoy. 'S' buoy shall be left to starboard unless otherwise designated by the race committee. All yachts are to monitor VHF Channel 72 during the starting sequence for additional sailing instructions.

The course diagrams shall be removed and replaced with the following:

Long Course Option


At the discretion of the R/C, on days when the wind is <u>consistently</u> 10-12+ knots, R/C may run the long course option. Refer to the chart above for the marks used based on wind direction.
