## 9/6 Additional Information: IMPORTANT

Competitors: The potential for a strong south breeze presents our launching situation with a difficult set of logistical challenges. We are STRONGLY RECOMMENDING that you bring a 12-15 lb danforth anchor, 10 feet of chain, and 50 feet of line to moor your boat on the north side of the yacht club point. The point protects from the large waves and wind which will make the launching process from the ramps VERY slow. Boats will be towed around from the launch area, and water taxis can pick you up and bring you back to the club. The other option is to remain in the lot, where we estimate it could take up to 5 minutes to launch per boat, and could require crew to get in the water. Doing this for 70 boats is not ideal.

One last note: there will be no powerboat launching at the club. The best place to launch is at Butch's, which is on the south side of Clam River across from the Dockside.
