**[NP]** Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. **This changes RRS 60.1(a)**

**1 SCHEDULE OF RACES**

The first warning signal will be at 1830 for all races between 9/15/21 and 9/29/21.

**3 COURSES**

3.1 No later than the warning signal, the race committee signal vessel will display the course number. If Course 2 is displayed, it will include the approximate compass bearing and distance of the drop mark. **[NP]** Course information may also be signalled by courtesy broadcast on the designated VHF Channel.

3.2 COURSE 1

Start	Leave Signal boat to Starboard	41° 52.8' N 087° 35.4'W
Four Mile Crib	Round to Port	41° 52.4' N 087° 32.7'W
Finish	Leave Signal boat to Port	41° 52.8' N 087° 35.4'W



## COURSE 2

	<b>Rounding/ Crossing Direction</b>	<b>Approximate Location</b>
Start	Leave Signal boat to Starboard	41° 52.8' N 087° 35.4'W
Orange Drop Mark	Round to Port	
Finish	Leave Signal boat to Port	41° 52.8' N 087° 35.4'W

### **4 START**

- 4.1 Races will be started using RRS 26.
- 4.2 The Start for both courses will be south of the Outer Monroe Harbor Breakwater at a heading of 180° between the orange flag on the signal boat and the course side of an inflatable mark.
- 4.3 The Starting Sequence will be:
  - 1. Green/JAM
  - 2. Spin 3 & Spin 2
  - 3. Spin 1 & Turbo
- 4.4 The race committee may combine classes for a start by displaying both class flags at the warning.
- 4.5 The race committee may omit starts with no competitors.
- 4.6 Per CBCS SI 12.1, all boats are required to check-in.

### **5 FINISH**

- 5.1 The Finish for both courses will be between the blue flag on the signal boat and the Chicago Harbor Outer Breakwater South End Light.
- 5.2 Boats approaching the Finishing area shall illuminate their sail numbers on their Main sail so they can be identified after dusk. Failure to do so may result in a score of DNF without a hearing if a boat cannot be identified. ***This changes rules 35, 63.1, A4, and A5.***
