THIS IS A FUNDRAISING REGATTA. The entry fee is \$100.00. Skippers and crew are encouraged to solicit additional sponsorship for their boat to support St. Vincent's SWIM Fundraiser.

Start/Racing Area: The racing/starting area will be in the vicinity between "2A" (Black Rock Harbor) and the Bridgeport Channel Entrance, unless otherwise designated by the race committee on VHF channel 68.

Schedule of Events:

- 0830 Fayerweather YC opens
- 1030 Skippers Meeting
- 1100 Harbor Start
- 1200 First Warning
- 1530 No warning signal will be made after this time
- 1630 Picnic at FYC for all competitors w/ live band

Eligibility: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker boats with a valid PHRF certificate are eligible. Any boat is eligible to race in the Navigator Division, with or without a valid PHRF Cert. ECSA and YRALIS PHRF certificates are valid for this event. YRALIS PHRF will be the standard for this regatta, ECSA boats PHRF will be adjusted to the YRALIS rating. PHRF certification alterations will be managed by the Racing Committee prior to the start of the regatta.



Race Management: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The RRS, 2021 - 2024.

Course: The courses will be windward/leeward for Spin. Non Spin and Navigator division may sail a different course from the Spinnaker division.

Classes: There will be Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker and Navigator divisions.

Free Dockage: Fayerweather Yacht Club will provide free dockage for the regatta weekend (Friday & Saturday). FYC monitors VHF 14 and their phone number is (203) 576-6796 (space permitting, raft up may be required). BRYC will also have a limited number of guest moorings available for the weekend. BRYC monitors VHF 14 and their phone number is (203) 335-0587.

SI's Sailing Instructions and Scratch Sheets will be available online at Yachtscoring.com.

Scoring: Time-on-Time scoring system will be used. The race committee, at their discretion, may run more than one race. If additional races are sailed, combined scores from all races will be used. There will be no throw-outs.

Prizes/Awards: Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place finishers in each division.
