SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT 1

For the avoidance of doubt: The scheduled start time for Sunday, Aug 15 is 1100 (not 1000 per the NOR). This is subject to further postponement due to a competing event which may delay the beach launch.

The following changes are made prior to racing on Aug 14:

ADD TO SI 1.3 AND SI 19.1: NEMA Multihulls will be scored as ToT, using the NEMA Rating system.

<u>ADD SI 1.5:</u> Vehicle parking is not allowed on the lawn at Fort Adams. All vehicles must be parked in the designated spaces, adjacent to the lawn, or in the paved lot located southwest of the Sail Newport property. (Exception: Trailers may be parked on the lawn for the duration of the regatta.)

<u>CHANGE SI 3.2:</u> Sailors are strongly encouraged to monitor VHF channel 71 <u>from the time of launch to</u> <u>15 minutes after starting</u> for any RC information. Failure of RC VHF communications shall not be grounds for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

<u>CHANGE SI 4.1:</u> Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the Official Notice Board <u>no later</u> <u>than 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start time</u> (or removal of AP ashore, whichever is later) on the day it will take effect. <u>Failure of the RC to post within the time limit shall not be grounds for redress by a boat.</u> <u>This changes RRS 62.1(a).</u>

CHANGE SI 7.1: Refer to the table below. It is the intention of the RC to start the divisions in numerical order; however, the RC reserves the right to change the order and/or combine starts of multiple classes.

<u>CHANGE SI 9.1:</u> The planned course for each day <u>(including location of start and finish lines)</u> shall be announced at the Competitors Meeting and posted <u>no later than 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start time</u> (or removal of AP ashore, whichever is later) on the day it will take effect. <u>Failure of the RC to post within the time limit shall not be grounds for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 62.1(a).</u>

<u>DELETE SI 9.2 AND REPLACE WITH:</u> <u>The RC reserves the right to change the planned course on the water prior to the start, and will communicate the course on VHF 71.</u>

DELETE SI 13.2 (refer to new SI 19.3)

<u>CHANGE SI 17.2.3:</u> Unless she retires, a boat failing to reach a mark by its designated time limit will be scored as <u>DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.</u>

<u>ADD SI 19.3:</u> A boat that is scored DNC, DNS, OCS, DNF, RET or DSQ will be assigned a corrected finish time equal to 20 minutes after the corrected finish time of last place boat of the day in her class. This changes RRS A5.

ADD SI 19.4: A boat that is scored DNE will be disqualified from the event. This changes RRS A5.

<u>CHANGE SI 20.1:</u> Any boat receiving outside assistance will be scored <u>as DNF without a hearing.</u> The race committee, US Coast Guard and state or local maritime authorities may decide when a boat needs assistance. *This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.*
