

420 White sail- twice around:

Start -1 (port) -1a (port) -2s/2p (gate) -1 (port) -1a (port) -2p (port) -F Finish.

- 7.4 If mark 1a is not present it will be omitted from the rounding order.
- 7.5 Mark 1a will NOT be replaced if there is a change of course.
- 7.6 If either of mark 2s/2p are missing, the remaining mark will be rounded to port.
- 7.7 Alpha course is approximately **0.25 miles South East** of the PCYC harbour entrance.
- 7.8 The VHF radio channel for Alpha course is 09.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 15.1 All competitors shall Check-out with their Pod Volunteer prior to leaving the harbor.
- 15.2 All competitors shall Check-in with their Pod Volunteer immediately upon returning to the harbour.
- 15.3 No competitor shall launch until Flag D is displayed (see 4.4).
- 15.4 All competitors shall sail past the stern of their signal boat on starboard tack to check in with the Race Committee.
- 15.5 Failure to comply with 15.2 by the end of protest time shall result in a competitor having points equal to 10% of the fleet rounded upwards to the nearest whole number added to their score for the first violation, and 20% for the second violation, in either case without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1, A3 and A5. Any boat so penalized may request redress under RRS 62.1 if the competitor believes the race committee made an error.
- 15.6 In a general emergency, **CODE Flag V** will be displayed on the Signal Boat. All support boats shall be considered safety boats and be under the direction of the Race Committee on the designated Radio channel. (see RRS 37)

1.2 RULE 61.1 "Informing the Protestee"

Add to rule 61.1(a): "The protesting boat shall also inform the Race Committee of the boat(s) being protested at the finishing line promptly after finishing, without interfering with the finish of other boats, or as soon as practical after retirement."






