

RULES

The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to all yachts with a valid 2022 LMPHRF certificate of handicap, and which meet current USCG regulations.
- 2.2 Eligible yachts may enter by completing the registration form, providing their valid LMPHRF certificate and proof of insurance, and paying the required fee during the registration period.
- 2.3 Registration will be done exclusively online. Visit www.mmyc.org/100miler to register.
- 2.4 Entry will close at 5:00 pm on Friday, July 29, 2022.

3. CLASSIFICATION and FEES

- 3.1 Early registration discounts apply to registrations with payment processed before 12:00 am Central, July 9, 2022.
- 3.2 **Spinnaker Division** 41.8 nm \$120.00 | On or after July 9, 2022 \$140.00
- 3.3 Non-Spinnaker Division 35.8 nm \$95.00 | On or after July 9, 2022 \$115.00
- 3.4 Small Boats Non-Spin Division (optional for boats 30.00' LOA or less) 16.4 nm \$70.00 | On or after July 9, 2022 \$90.00
- 3.5 Section breaks will be done within each division to promote competition.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 **Sign-In.** Friday, July 29, 11:00 am 5:00 pm. The yacht's owner, or an owner's representative, must sign in at the registration desk inside M&M Yacht Club. Yachts failing to sign in may not be scored at the discretion of Race Committee.
- 4.2 **100 Miler First Warning:** Saturday, July 30, 9:00 am.
- 4.3 Other Events:

5. MEASUREMENTS

All yachts must produce a valid MWPHRF (formerly LMPHRF) certificate.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSE

This information will be distributed at **Sign-In** during the period described in 4.1 above.

7. VENUE

- 7.1 All onshore events will be held at M&M Yacht Club, 730 First Street, Menominee, MI.
- 7.2 Racing shall take place in the waters of the Bay of Green Bay.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Yacht finishes or place will be determined by corrected time from fastest to slowest. Corrected time will be calculated using time on distance formulas.
- 8.2 Spinnaker Division yachts will be handicapped using MWPHRF DHCP.
- 8.3 Non-Spinnaker and Non-Spin small boats will be handicapped using MWPHRF NSHCP.

9. PRIZES

Brag flags will be awarded to the top finishers in each division and section. Overall winners will be inscribed on the perpetual trophies at M&M Yacht Club.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, "Decision to Race." Neither M&M Yacht Club, Inc., nor its officers and members, nor the race committee, will accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained by any person in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.

11. INSURANCE

Each yacht must be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Proof of insurance must be provided if not on file at M&M Yacht Club.
