Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole at the Sail Training building.


The skipper's meeting will take place at 9:00 Saturday on the grass directly beside the workshop.

7.0 Racing Area


Racing will take place approximately 1-1.5 miles NE of the Sarnia Yacht Club Harbour (See below)

10.0 Obstructions - Fishing Nets
