## **Sailing Instructions - Amendment 1**

**SI 3.4.1.** has been changed to read: A competitors' hail for all classes will be made each day at 0900 on VHF 72. This hail will contain relevant racing information such as the intended location of the Starting Area for each Circle, as well as any expected Postponement on Shore due to weather. **SI** 

**6.1.** has been changed to read: Dates of racing

Classes	Race Dates	Number of Races per day
Sportboats	July 4 – July 8, 2022	Up to 5 races
MD, JAM, Multihull	July 4 – July 8, 2022	Up to 2 races

- **SI 6.2.** has been changed to read: The scheduled time of the first warning signal for the first race each day will be:
  - **6.2.1.** Circle 1. 1100 hours
  - **6.2.2.** Circle 2. 1000 hours
- **SI 6.2.** has been changed to read: Postponement on shore for each Race Circle may be announced via VHF at 0900 hrs. each day
- **SI 8.2.2.** has been changed to read: Circle 2 will run Sport Boats when fleet racing is using buoy courses. The location for Circle 2 will be in Pikes Bay, approximately 1.0 nm SE of the entrance to Port Superior Marina. The approximate location is listed as Starting Area 8 on Appendix A Waypoint Coordinates.
- SI 9.1. has been changed to read: Sport Boat Fleets Course diagrams are included in Appendix B.
- **SI 9.3.** has been changed to read: Sport Boat Fleets, at the discretion of the RC, may sail a windward leeward course as described in SI 9.1 or a mid-distance course as described in SI 9.2.
- **SI 13.1.** has been changed to read: Sport Boat Fleets:



**SI 15.**1. has been changed to read: The Race Time Limit (See RRS 35) and the Finishing Window (FW) for boats within a class or fleet are shown in the table below.

Class/Fleet	Time limit (hours)	Finishing Window (hours)
Sport Boat (Buoy Course)	3	0.5
Sport Boat (Mid Distance Course)	4	1
MD/JAM/Multihull	4	1.5
Memorial Cup	5	1
