## Notice of Race

with Amendment No. 1

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

### 1 RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. J/105 Class Rules are modified by Article IX of the local J/105 Fleet-3 Article/Rules. This event is designated Level 2C. J/105 Fleet-3 Articles/Rules can be found at [www.j105fleet3.org/rules](http://www.j105fleet3.org/rules).
- 1.3. [NP] Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at [www.eastportyc.org/racing](http://www.eastportyc.org/racing), located under "Racing Resources."
- 1.4. [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct. Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available after 2000 hours on Friday, 10 June 2022 at [www.eastportyc.org/one-design](http://www.eastportyc.org/one-design).

### 3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. The online official notice board is located at [www.eastportyc.org/one-design](http://www.eastportyc.org/one-design).
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 9, 13, 16, and 73.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4. [DP] Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. This event is open to boats of the following classes, provided five (5) or more paid registrations are received by 1200 hours on Friday, 10 June 2022:

- 4.2. Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of five (5) or more paid entries by 1200 hours on Friday, 10 June 2022. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by 1200 hours on Friday, 17 June 2022.

## 5 FEES

- 5.1. The entry fees are as follows:

- \$70 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 10 June 2022.
- \$85 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 10 June 2022, but before 1200 hours on Friday, 17 June 2022.

- 5.2. A 50% entry fee will be refunded if a request to withdraw from the event is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 11 June 2022.

## 6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1. The schedule of events is:

- 6.2. A maximum of four (4) races will be held with the last warning no later than 1530 hours.

## 7 VENUE

- 7.1. The event venue will be the EYC, 317 First Street, Annapolis, MD, 21403.
- 7.2. The racing area will be the Chesapeake Bay, in the vicinity of the mouth of the Severn River as shown in Attachment 1.
- 7.3. EYC extends the courtesy of its bar and galley to race participants for post-race socials and the awards presentation.

## 8 COURSES

- 8.1. Courses will be windward/leeward courses described in the SIs.

## 9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1. RRS US Sailing Prescription Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, will apply.
- 9.2. Hearings conducted in accordance with the rules of RRS Part 5, [Hearings & Decisions] will be virtual hearings and parties, parties' representatives and witnesses to such hearings shall have access to a device that has internet accessibility with audio and video capability; parties and witnesses must use audio and video to appear before a hearing panel unless advised otherwise by the hearing panel. ## 10 SCORING

- 10.1. Four (4) races are scheduled, of which one (1) scored race is required to constitute a series.
- 10.2. A boat's series score will be the total of all of her race scores.





- 10.3. Rule A5.3 applies to all boats that finish.
- 10.4. RRS 90.3 (e) will apply with the time limit changed to seven (7) days. This changes RRS 90.3 (e).

## **11 RISK STATEMENT**

- 11.1. Boats participate in the One-Design Classic entirely at their own risk; see RRS 3, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority (OA) will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

## **12 INSURANCE**

- 12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

## **13 PRIZES**

- 13.1. Overall prizes will be presented at an awards ceremony at EYC following the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 18 June 2022. The prizes are as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place for five (5) or more entries,
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place for six (6) or more entries.

- 13.2. Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the OA.
