- 1.3. Double handed entries may use self-steering devices during sail changes only. *This changes RRS* 52.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.2. The Race Committee will use VHF Ch. 01A (1001) for courtesy broadcasts to competitors.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The race is open to PHRF, ORC and One Design boats.
- 4.2. Classes shall be assigned by the Race Committee.
- 4.3. Ratings issues shall be resolved by the Technical Committee.
- 4.4. All entrants shall hold adequate insurance.
- 4.5. Registration and payment is online at www.mudhead.org/RACING.
- 4.6. Entry deadline is Thursday, July 28 at 2330.

5. FEES

5.1. The entry fee is \$35.00 per boat for this race.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Registration opens online April 1, 2022.
- 6.2. The First Warning is scheduled at 1755 EDT on Friday, July 29, 2022.
- 6.3. The Time Limit is 1800 EDT, Saturday, July 30, 2022.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The Starting Area is in the vicinity of Horseshoe Reef.
- 7.2. Courses selected by the Race Committee will be 45 to 70 NM around designated marks in Block Island, Long Island and Fishers Island Sounds and Gardiners Bay.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. There are no exclusions.
- 8.2. This is an ECSA Offshore Circuit double points race.
