Supplement to RRS Appendix S (Standard Sailing Instructions)

Revision 1: Posted August 1, 2023

1 COMMUNICATION

- 1.1 [NoR 3.3] On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 71.
- 1.2 If the race committee displays flag 'G', alternative VHF channel 72 will be used.

2 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 2.1 [RRS Appendix S 4.1] Signals made ashore will be made at the flagpole nearest the A-Frame clubhouse.
- 2.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced by 'not less than 60 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first day of racing is $\frac{1200}{1100}$.
- 3.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for subsequent days of racing is 1000.
- 3.3 The date of the distance race will be posted by 2000 on the day before it starts.
- 3.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1430.

4 COURSES


- 4.1 [RRS Appendix S new instruction 7.3] If one of the leeward gate marks is missing, boats shall round the existing mark leaving it to port.
- 4.2 The course will not be shortened to less than 3 legs. The offset leg (1 to 1a) is not considered to be a leg for this purpose.
- 4.3 The course and other instructions for the distance race will be posted by 2000 on the day before it starts. Those instructions may make changes to this supplement.
- 4.4 SI Addendum C shows the river legs for the distance race. Under the International Shark Class Association championship rule 9 b):
 - (a) The length of the race from the start to the lake gate (marks LP and LS) will be no less than 24 km.
 - (b) The length of the race from the start to the finishing line will be no greater than 42 km.
- 4.5 The distance race may be shortened at the lake gate. This changes the International Shark Class Association championship rule 10 a).

5 MARKS

- 5.1 [RRS Appendix S 8.1] Marks will be as follows:
 - (a) The starting marks will be a red inflatable tetrahedron (port-end), the race committee signal vessel and a green inflatable tetrahedron (starboard end),
 - (b) Marks 1, 2p and 2s will be orange inflatable tetrahedrons,
 - (c) Mark 1a will be a red inflatable ball,
 - (d) The finishing marks will be a green inflatable tetrahedron and the race committee signal vessel,
 - (e) New marks as provided in RRS Appendix S 10.1 will be yellow inflatable tetrahedrons.

6 THE START

- 6.1 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.
- 6.2 The starting lines will be:
 - (a) between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the port-end starting mark, and
 - (b) between a staff displaying a green flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the starboard-end starting mark. This changes the RRS Appendix S course diagrams.
 - (c) If the starboard-end starting mark is missing, only (a), above, will apply.




7 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

- 7.1 [New instruction 10.2 to RRS Appendix S] If the windward marks (1 and 1a) are changed, they will be replaced by a single mark.
- 7.2 [New instruction 10.3 to RRS Appendix S] If the leeward gate (marks 2p and 2s) is changed, they will be replaced by a single mark which shall be left to port.

8 THE FINISH

- 8.1 The finishing mark will be left to port as in the diagram to the right. This changes the RRS Appendix S course diagrams for courses L, LA, and TL.
- 8.2 [RRS Appendix S 11.1] If it is deemed by the race committee that a boat, or a few boats, can finish within the Finishing Window, the race committee may award finishing positions to these boats. The awarding of such a score will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 28.1.



9 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

- 9.1 [RRS Appendix S 12.1]:
 - (a) The Mark 1 time limit is 60 minutes.
 - (b) The Race Time Limit is 2 ½ hours.
 - (c) The Finishing Window is 40 minutes.
- 9.2 [RRS Appendix S new instruction 12.4] The target time is 75 minutes. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1 (a).

10 PROTESTS

- 10.1 The race office will be at the A-Frame clubhouse.
- 10.2 The protest time limit is 45 minutes after the race committee vessel has signalled her return to her mooring. This changes RRS Appendix S 13.2.
- 10.3 Protest notices: '30 minutes' is replaced with '10 minutes' in RRS Appendix S 13.3.

11 SAFETY REGULATIONS

11.1 [NP] [DP] A boat that retires from the race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

12 OFFICIAL VESSELS

- 12.1 Official <u>race committee</u> vessels other than the signal vessel will display a white Shark insignia on a blue background.
- 12.2 Jury vessels will fly the jury flag (letter J on a white background).
