

NOTICE OF RACE

HAMPTON ONE-DESIGN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Hampton One Design Class Racing Association
Cambridge, Maryland - August 19, 20 & 21 2022

WHERE: Registration and launch facilities at the Cambridge Yacht Club, Cambridge, Maryland. Races will be sailed on the Choptank River.

WHEN: Registration and check-in for this regatta will be from 1000-1150 on Friday, August 19. A competitors meeting will be held at noon on that day. Six races are scheduled as follows:

<i>4</i>	<i>Saturday, Aug. 20</i>	<i>Immediately after Race 3</i>
<i>5</i>	<i>Saturday, Aug. 20</i>	<i>Immediately after Race 4</i>
<i>6</i>	<i>Sunday, Aug. 21</i>	<i>1030 -- Warning Signal</i>
<i>Make-up</i>	<i>Sunday, Aug. 21</i>	<i>Immediately after Race 6, if required</i>

No races will be started after 1500, Sunday, August 21. Four races must be completed to constitute a series. There will be a throw-out if all six races are completed.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), together with the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Hampton One Design class rules and the Sailing Instructions.

CLASSES: All Hampton One Design owners that are current members of the HOD Class are eligible to enter. The Hampton One Design National Executive Committee will make final decisions on eligibility, including waiver of eligibility requirements.

EQUIPMENT: Competitors are reminded that the class rules require each boat to carry a paddle, an anchor, 50 feet of anchor line, and life jackets for the skipper and crew. This equipment must be available for verification by class measurers between 1000 and 1150 Friday morning. The Sailing Instructions will also specify the use of **VHF radios** for all competitors, and the Race Committee may use VHF radios to communicate important information to competitors.

ENTRY FEE: Competitors must pre-register; registration materials and instructions available at Yacht Scoring at <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=15340> The early registration fee is \$350, which includes 3 days of racing, dinner and parties on Friday and Saturday nights for skipper and crew along with bagels, coffee and donuts in the AM and on the water lunch on Saturday. An additional \$50 will be charged if registration is not paid by August 4th. Pre-registered competitors must check in at the registration table on Friday morning between 1000 and 1150 for Sailing Instructions, equipment forms, T-shirts and meal tickets. Additional guest tickets for the weekend may be purchased for \$40 prior to August 4th or \$50 thereafter.
