

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, and the International One-Design, J/70, Ensign, and Watch Hill 15 classes (in those classes); except as any of these are modified by the sailing instructions.

- 1.2 PHRF and ORC classes will be scored by the time-on-time method.
- 1.3 Rule 3, Decision to Race, is reiterated.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at yachtscoring.com by 1800, Friday, Sept. 2.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The event is open to all boats with a valid PHRF or ORC certificate, yachts in the International One-Design, J70, Watch Hill 15, and Ensign classes, and by invitation.

- 3.2 The FIYC Race Committee will assign entries to specific classes based on PHRF, ORC and One Design classifications.
- 3.3 Register, sign waivers and buy party tickets via Yacht Scoring link on www.fiyc.net
- 4 FEES

4.1 Entry donation: Yacht \$45 US Sailing member \$65 US Sailing non-member Party Ticket Advance purchase: \$25/adult; \$15/child At the door: \$30/adult; \$20/child

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Entries close 1800, Thursday, September 1.
- 5.2 Class assignments available on yachtscoring.com, 1800, Friday, Sept. 2.
- 5.3 First Warning: 1000, Saturday, Sept. 3.
- 5.4 Entertainment at FIYC (pending Covid restrictions) begins immediately after the race

6 COURSE

6.1 All classes will start and finish just outside West Harbor, Fishers Island. The race will be around Fishers Island, approximately 15 miles.

6.2 Course designations will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

7 AWARDS

7.1 1st, 2nd, 3rd-place trophies in each class.
Commodore David F. Harris Trophy—1st FIYC boat entered in a PHRF class.
Island Cup Trophy, combined scoring in FIYC, Masons Island YC & Ram Island YC races.
Wilkinson Trophy for fastest Corrected Time using PHRF for all boats.
