Notice of Regatta
AMENDMENT #1

The following sections of the Notice of Regatta are hereby deleted and the following inserted therefore:

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing; the prescriptions of US Sailing; the PHRF Regulations as administered by the YRA of Long Island Sound; and the current US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) for Near Shore events.

1.2 All boats are strongly encouraged to follow the STC Safety Guidelines. These guidelines are available on the website: <https://stormtrysail.org/STC-Safety-Guideline-and-Rendering-Assistance.pdf>

2. Eligibility

The regatta is open to any boat with a current YRA LIS PHRF Certificate.

7. Courses

7.1 Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7.2 Saturday and Sunday courses will Navigator type for Spinnaker and non-spinnaker boats.

7.3 The first mark of the course may be a mark set to windward of the start.

8. Scoring

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply with the following changes: Boats failing to finish within the time limit window will be scored TLE (Time Limit Expired) and scored points equal to the number of finishers in that race plus two, but in no case will be scored more than the number of starters. This adds to RRS Appendix A10.

8.2 All boats will be scored Time-on-Time.

8.3 There will be no discard races in the series. This changes RRS Appendix A 2.

8.4 One completed race shall constitute the regatta.
