NOTICE OF RACE

As amended 9/5/22, 1700

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of US Sailing shall apply.
- 1.3. The Class Rules of the Ideal 18 Class shall apply except as modified by this Notice of Race.
 - 1.3.1. The hull surface below the top waterline stripe shall have an anti-fouling bottom paint or coating.
 - 1.3.2. Boats shall be raced by two persons.
- 1.4. The Organizing Authority may require that boats be inspected to ensure compliance with on-board equipment requirements.
- 1.5. Use of abrasives for cleaning (i.e. wet-sanding bottom) is prohibited and if observed by a representative from IHYC, subject to disqualification from the series without a hearing.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Competitor advertising on boats will not be permitted.
- 2.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3. Eligibility, Entry & Fees

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Ideal 18 Class, subject to the rules stated in this notice of race.
- 3.2. Eligible boats shall enter by registering online at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>.
- 3.3. The entry fee is \$115/boat.

- 3.4. All entries with completed payment must be submitted online and received prior to September 14, 2022.
- 3.5. Entries requesting a charter boat must be completed prior to September 11, 2022.
- 3.6. The entry fee includes a continental breakfast with registration and buffet dinner with keg beer with awards.

4. Schedule of Events

Friday, September 16, 2022

1700-1900 Check-in & charter check-in. Charter boats accessible during this time.

Saturday, September 17, 2022

0800-0930 Check-in & Continental Breakfast in Ballroom

0930 Competitors' Meeting

Harbor Start

All boats must be afloat by 1000

First Warning Scheduled

*Awards with dinner will be presented as soon as practicable after racing ends.

5. Schedule of Races

The number of races sailed will be at the discretion of the race committee.

6. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available online prior to Friday September 16, 2022.

7. Venue

The racing area will be in Captain Harbor or on Long Island Sound south of the Captain Islands.

8. Courses

The intention of the race committee is to predominantly sail windward-leeward courses with a windward offset mark. Courses will be described in detail in the sailing instructions.

9. Penalty System & Protests

RRS Appendix V shall apply.

10. Scoring

- 10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of *RRS Appendix A* will be used.
- 10.2. One race is required to constitute the series.
 - 10.2.1. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

- 10.2.2. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score subject to RRS 90.3(b).
- 10.2.3. The combined scores of the three top finishers from each YRALIS member club or association will determine the Team Champion.

11. Prizes

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers for skipper and crew.
- 11.2. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 11.3. This regatta is a qualifying event for the YRALIS Sally Finkbeiner Trophy.

12. Charters

- 12.1. A limited number of charter boats are available on a first-come basis. Boats are provided "as is" and will include all necessary equipment and sails. No claims are made to the condition of the sails and other equipment. Charterers are encouraged to provide their own sails, clean the bottoms of their boats (as per NOR 1.5), and bring any spare or extra gear they may require.
- 12.2. Boat charter must be selected during online registration.
- 12.3. There is a \$75 per boat charter fee, payable online during registration. This fee is separate from the registration fee outlined above., and is not subject to the same early discount or late fee.
- 12.4. During check-in a waiver and damage deposit form shall be completed by the charterer. Liability for damage to property, including the Ideal 18 sailboats used in the event will be limited to the insurance deductible amount, which is \$500 per incident.
- 12.5. Charterers are strongly encouraged to check in on Friday to have an opportunity to assess the boat and equipment.
- 12.6. Charter boats will be randomly assigned by the organizing authority.
- 12.7. Requests for charter are subject to NOR 3.5.
