NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the RRS 2021- 2024, including Appendices F & B.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta entries will include Open Kite Hydrofoils and Open Wing Foilers and Open Windfoil Windsurfers (incl. IQ Foil class)
 - 2.2 No entries accepted after 2000 hrs on Wednesday November 2, 2022, without approval by the Principal Race Officer.
- 2.3 Registration is done online through Yacht Scoring and can also be found at SPYC website under "Regattas"
 4. Youth competitors (under the age of 18) shall be required to complete the following: **Online at Yacht Scoring:**
 - **Parental Release for Youth Participation In SPYC Events Waiver**
- 2.5 An entry is not considered complete until both the entry form, fee and waiver have been received through Yacht Scoring.
- 2.6 Open Kite Hydrofoils entries are limited to 20 completed entries. After 20 Open Kite Hydrofoil entries have been received a wait list shall be created. Kite entries please designate your division. Division A will sail 2xs around the course and Division B will sail 1x around the course. Division A and Division B will start together.
- 2.7 Windfoilers (incl. IQ Foil Class) may start together.
- 2.8 Wing Foilers Class may sail an inshore racecourse. The SIs will designate course (s).

3 FEE

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$120 this includes the deposit of \$20 for the assigned Pinni to be worn at all times while afloat. Once Pinni is returned at the end of the event \$20 will be refunded.
- 3.2 Registration refunds are available through a written request to Regatta OA by Midnight Monday, October 31, 2022 with a \$25.00 fee and the balance of the entry refunded.

5 VENUE

The Skyway Bridge East Side North end on Pinellas County side if an Easterly breeze is present or Pass A Grille Beach, Pass a Grille, Florida when any Westerly, SW, W, NW is present.

6 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the sailing instructions.

7 ADVERTISING

7.1 World Sailing Regulation 20 - Advertising Code- shall apply.

7.2 Competitors may be required to carry advertising for event and class sponsors on their boards, kiteboards, sails, lines, and on a Pinni, if supplied by the OA.

8 IDENTIFICATION

Every competitor is required to wear the official event Lycra/Pinni with their personal identification number whenever going afloat during the event.

9 BUOYANCY

9.1 The use of personal flotation devices is prescribed, every competitor and support boat crew member shall wear, above the waist, a jacket, harness, or vest with a minimum buoyancy of 4kg uninflated in fresh water.

9.2 Helmets are mandatory.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on Yacht Scoring as the official notice board no later than the first competitor's briefing.

11 SCORING

11.1 The low point system of Appendix A will apply.

11.2 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta, scores will be posted on Yacht Scoring.

11.3 (a)When 5 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her races scores. (b) When from 6 to 11 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.(c) When 12 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM - Appendix B & F will apply for specific classes

13 PRIZES

Awards include 1st-3rd place in each class; Kite, Windfoils (men, women, youth) -and Wingfoils.. A Champion Trophy will be presented to the First Place Finisher for each class.

14 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone. The organizing authority and its sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14.2 The Skipper/Owner of each boat participating in the Regatta shall be responsible for the behavior of each member of the crew of his/her boat both on the water and while ashore. The failure of any of those persons to comply with all federal, state, and local government regulations as well as the St Petersburg Yacht Club policies or with any reasonable request of the Organizing Authority, Race Officers, or their representatives may result in the disqualification of the boat and its exclusion from the regatta. This modifies RRS 76.

15 TELEVISION AND MEDIA

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant the organizing authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said event as defined in the notice of race and sailing instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
