

# 2022 NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. Venue: St. Lucia, Windward Islands
- 2. Date: 25-27 November 2022
- 3. **Organising Authority**: The St. Lucia Yacht Club under the auspices of the Saint Lucia Sailing Association. Notice Boards will be located at both the St. Lucia Yacht Club and at IGY Rodney Bay Marina.
- 4. Classes: Boats (may) enter in one of the following classes:
  - Racing: (spinnaker) CSA Certificate
  - Cruising 1: (non-spinnaker, upwind sails only) CSA Certificate
  - **Cruising 2:** (non-spinnaker, upwind sails only) CSA Simplified Rating Rule (Intended for live aboard and/or boats without a CSA Measurement Certificate
  - J24: (One Design Class, spinnaker)
  - Surprise: (One Design Class, spinnaker)
  - 5. Registration
    - Entry Fee: \$110EUR/\$295XCD
    - We urge you to Pre-Register Online by Wednesday 16 November: Complete and send entry form (<u>https://form.jotform.com/lilybergasse/mango-bowl-regatta-registration-for</u> see Facebook page to download), <u>plus</u> valid CSA Certificate or Simplified CSA Rating Form where required, to the Regatta Director: <u>mangobowlslyc@gmail.com</u> who will confirm receipt
    - Payment will be made in person on arrival.
    - Registration in person at IGY Marina 1600h-1900h on Friday November 25
    - Entrants in the Racing or Cruising 1 Classes must have a valid CSA Measurement Certificate.
    - Entrants in **Cruising 1 or Cruising 2** must declare their intended sail configuration by close of registration at 1900h on Friday 25 November.
    - <u>Insurance: All Yachts entered must, before the registration deadline, sign the declaration</u> provided, stating they have insurance which covers participation in yacht races.
  - Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the 2021-2024 including the J24 Class Declaration and CSA rating rule and all Amendments in the Notice of Race, except where any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.
  - 7. **Safety**: All boats shall comply with the MBR Minimum Safety Requirements as posted on the MBR Facebook page. The Race Committee may conduct spot checks during the regatta. Any boat found to be deficient may be protested. No anchors shall be carried over the bow or stern while racing if seen this WILL lead to disqualification from that and any other race it is carried. It is further recommended that participants utilize ISAF Off Shore Special Regulations Appendix B.



8. **Amendments**: The Race Committee reserves the right to add, subtract, amalgamate or rearrange classes, races or start times dependent on entry numbers.

### 9. Race Schedule, Number of Races and First Warning

The first warning shall be before 0855hrs for the first race of the day.

- Cruising Class 1: 3 Races
- Cruising Class 2: 3 Races
- Racing Class: 3 Races
- J/24, Surprise: 6 Races

#### Sunday


- Cruising Class 1: 2 Races

- 10. **Protest**: The close of Protest Time for each Class will be one hour after the last boat (in each class) has finished the last race of the day. Protest forms will be enclosed with the Skippers Pack and available at Race HQ. There will be a \$100.00EUR/\$265XCD deposit for each protest filed which is refundable if the protest is won.
- 11. **Scoring:** The low point scoring system Appendix A as modified by the Sailing instructions shall be used.
