Supplemental Sailing Instructions

1. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located on the yachtscoring website.
2. The Official Race Office will be the "Junior Room" at the Charleston Yacht Club.
3. Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole at the ChYC.
4. For an on-the-water change to the SIs, in accordance with RRS 90.2(c): the "L" flag shall be displayed with a sound, and will be followed by a broadcast hail of the change on the designated VHF channel.

5. Schedule of Events

Saturday April 27, 2024

1000 Skippers Meeting at ChYC. Check in and waivers signed. Pick up Skippers bags.

1130 First planned warning signal

1800 Awards and Sponsor Party (or 1 hour after last boat finishes last race of the day))

6. Course Description and Marks

Courses are intended to be LA 2, and will be posted on Signal Boat.

Mark 1 will be a yellow cylinder

Mark 1a. This is an offset mark and will be a pink ball

2s and 2p will be orange cylinders

The starting marks will be a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Signal vessel and an white ball to the port side of the signal boat. The Finish will be the same as the starting line, which updates Appendix S11.

7. Time Limits

Each race will have a 90 minute time limit for the first finisher, and a secondary time limit of 20 minutes. Any yacht that does not finish in the finishing window will be score a place one more than the number of boats that finished.

8. Radio Broadcast: The RC will communicate on VHF. This channel will be announced at the Skippers Meeting

9. Class Flag: The Class Flag will be the J105 class emblem.
