**Venue:** The 2023 Lake Lanier Melges 24 regatta is being hosted by Lake Lanier Sailing Club, 6206 Commodore Drive, Flowery Branch Georgia 30542

LLSC is on Lake Lanier, a beautiful deep lake in the foothills of North Georgia. Check-in will be at the LLSC club house. The racing will take place in Chattahoochee Bay, adjacent to LLSC. Information about LLSC may be found at [www.llsc.com](http://www.llsc.com)

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply

**Eligibility:** The Inland Championship is open to all class legal Melges 24. Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration on yacht scoring no later than March 24, 2023.

**Entry Fee:** Melges 24 \$60.00

**\$20.00** per dinner ticket for Saturday dinner

**Cutoff for Dinner tickets is March 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00PM**

**Scoring: Regatta Scoring** - the regatta will be scored as governed in appendix A of the racing rules, using the low points system. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the

total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**Alternative Penalties Melges 24:** RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe is required.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing instructions will be available at registration. Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Race Information Notice Board located inside the Lake Lanier Sailing Clubhouse. Changes in the sailing instructions will be posted on the LLSC Clubhouse bulletin board one hour prior to the start of the first race each day.

**Liability:** The Safety of the boat and crew shall be the sole responsibility of the boat's owner and/or owner's representative. The skipper and crew assume the risks of racing and agree not to sue race administrators. The skipper is responsible for the conduct of crew.

**Dockage & Launching:** Provided by Lake Lanier Sailing Club, included in registration fee. Boats may use the Lake Lanier Sailing Clubs launching ramp, and may dock overnight both Friday and Saturday using the outside (opposite ramp side) of the Dock located at the front entrance launch ramp, or other designated docks

Boats can possibly be stored at LLSC for a few weeks before or after If needed In case of travelling to or from another south eastern regatta. Please contact for approval.
