# 2.ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to PHRF, ORC and One Design classes. Spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes are available.
- 2.2 Entries will be accepted and assigned to classes at the discretion of the Race Committee. Yacht Scoring will be used.

### 3.FEES:

3.1 \$50.00 per boat, includes two tickets to Regatta Shore Party. Additional tickets \$30 each.

#### 4.SCHEDULE:

- 4.1 Skippers meeting will be at 6pm Friday, June 16th, 1800 hours followed by Cornhole Tournament. Registrations will be accepted until 6pm
- 4.2 First Warning will be at 1200 hrs, Saturday, June 17th.
- 4.3 One Race is scheduled for this event.
