AMENDMENT 1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

SI 6.3(b) is replaced with:

(b) For the Bay Circle:

- (1) For the J/105 class: Up to 3 drop mark races are scheduled for Saturday, and up to 3 drop mark races are scheduled for Sunday.
- (2) For ORC I and ORC II: Up to 2 drop mark races are scheduled for Saturday. One government mark race is scheduled for Sunday. The government mark race will be weighted at 1.25 for scoring purposes.
- (3) The warning signal for the first race is scheduled for 1100 both Saturday and Sunday.
- (4) No warning signal will be made after 1530 on Sunday.

SI 10.1(b) is replaced with:

- (b) The finishing mark will be a yellow cylinder or a Marksetbot.

SI 10.2 is replaced with:

10.2 For the Fall Series 2 government marks race:

- (a) Both the starting and finishing lines will be at the race committee signal vessel.
- (b) The rounding marks will use CBYRA Region III Standard Race Marks as described SI Attachment 2.
- (c) Government marks “1AH” (off Tolly Point), R“4” (off Greenbury Point), Thomas Point Light, and the Bloody Point Bar Warning Light shall be passed on the channel side at all times.
- (d) The course will be posted to the notice board no later than 0800 on Sunday.

SI 13.3 is added:

13.3 The signals for course changes signal affecting boats rounding the leeward mark/gates of drop marks courses may be made from the race committee signal vessel.

SI 14 is replaced with:

14.1 The finishing line for both drop marks and government marks courses will be between a staff or halyard displaying a blue flag on the race committee signal vessel and the course side of the nearby finishing mark. For the Bay Circle, the finishing mark will be ***on the opposite side*** of the race committee signal vessel from the starting line.
