





# Rainbow Regatta Notice of Race April 3 & 4, 2023

# 1.RULES

This regatta will be governed by rules in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

# 2.ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Open to all FWSA members
- 2.2 Open to all boats of the following Classes:
  - 2.2.a. Sunfish
  - 2.2.b. Prams hulls equipped without battened sails, with Pram dagger boards and Pram rudders.
  - 2.2.c. Optis hulls equipped with battened sails, with Opti dagger boards and Opti rudders.
- 2.3 All Classes must have at least 5 entries and at least 3 Clubs must be represented in that Class.
- 2.4 Opti and Pram Teams defined as two or more competitors from the same member club.
- 2.5 Individual Entries any number of Pram, Opti and Sunfish sailors
- 2.6 Entries must register online: www.spyc.org, Regattas, '2023 Apr 4 Rainbow Regatta.'
- 2.7 Volunteers and spectators can sign up and order lunch at: https://forms.gle/KM63ioN7Zzcj5Rk16
- 2.8 Deadline for entries: 1700, Mar 28, 2023.
- 2.9 Practice race will be offered Monday, Apr 3, 2023.

# 3. EQUIPMENT

- 3.1 Competitors shall wear a properly secured USCG approved personal floatation device with an attached whistle at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothes. Inflatable life vests are not permitted.
- 3.2 All prams and Optis shall have three floatation bladders, and rudder clip. All gear in the boat shall be tied or fastened in the boat.
- 3.3 All boats must be equipped with a floating tow line at least 26' long.
- 3.4 Pram sails should identify Club affiliation.

## 4. FEES

- 4.1 A non-refundable registration fee of \$55 per competitor will include one lunch.
- 4.2 Non-competitors should also register for lunch, \$25.

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Will be available online by April 1.

## 7. VENUE

Racing will occur in Tampa Bay east of downtown St Petersburg.

#### 8. COURSES

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be triangles, windward/leewards or some combination.
- 8.2 Sunfish will sail on a separate course from Optis and Prams.
- 8.3 All spectator and non-RC boats must remain 100 yards from the course and competitors at all times.

# 9. SCORING

- 9.1 Three races for each Class are scheduled.
- 9.2 One race will constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A, RRS, will apply, except no race will be excluded. (This changes RRS A2.)
- 9.4 Pram and Opti team sizes will be determined by the number of entries from the Club with the lowest number of entries (but not less than two.) This determines the number of competitors to be scored for the perpetual team trophies.

10.1 Awards will be given to the top five sailors in each Class, given at least 10 participants in that Class. If a Class has fewer than 10 competitors, prizes will be awarded to the top three sailors.

10.2 A "Rainbow Rookie" will be awarded for each Class. A Rookie is new to sailing and in her first year. 10.3 PERPETUAL TROPHIES:

10.3.a. Pram and Opti TEAM trophies will have the Club winners recorded on the trophies.

10.3.b. Overall Sunfish winner.

10.3.c. Sunfish, Pram and Masters(70+)

10.3.d. Sunfish Super Salt (60 – 69)

10.3.e. Sunfish Salt (50 to 59)

10.3.f. Apprentice Sunfish(<50)
