

2023 Lake Huron Championship Regatta August 19 NOTICE OF RACE



1 RULES

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- **1.2** The prescriptions of the US Sailing national authority will apply.
- **1.3** The minimum number of crew per boat is two (2).
- **1.4** The Midwest PHRF By-Laws and Handicapping Rules, Credits and Penalties (HRCP) will apply, and each boat shall have a current Midwest PHRF rating certificate.
- **1.5** One Design classes shown in the final splits shall comply with their class rules.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats shall display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20- ISAF Advertising Code.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Boats shall be entered by signing up on www.yachtscoring.com per Section 5.

4 FEES

4.1 Registration fee is \$20 and <u>must</u> be paid on Yachtscoring.com when completing 3.1.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- **5.1** Race date is Saturday August 19.
- **5.2** See SI's for warning signal.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- **6.1** The sailing instructions will be available by August 17 on www.yachtscoring.com.
- **6.2** Final SI's will be posted on the Yachtscoring race page.

7 CLASSES

- **7.1** Classes are PHRF and One Design.
- **7.2** Minimum yachts to form a class are five (5).

8 THE COURSES

- **8.1** Racing will take place in the blue waters of Lower Lake Huron within 2 miles of R4.
- **8.2** The courses will be windward/leeward courses using inflatable drop marks.

9 SCORING

9.1 In accordance with RRS A2, no scores will be excluded.

10 PRIZES

- **10.1** Flags will be given to the top three finishers in each class.
- 10.2 See SI's for additional awards.

11 DOCKAGE

- 11.1 Dockage and mooring will be available at PHYC.
- 11.2 PHYC hoist and ramp launch are available and free of charge to competitors.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See RSS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.

13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with a minimum of \$250,000 of third-party liability insurance.
