## AMENDMENT 1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### SI 9 COURSES - 9.4 is added:

9.4 If only a single gate mark is in place, it shall be rounded to port.

### SI 10 MARKS is replaced with:

10.1 Starting and finishing marks will be lime green cylinders or MarkSetBots. Mark 1a will be a lime green cylinder. All other marks of the course will be orange cylinders or MarkSetBots.

10.2 Change marks used in accordance with SIs will be orange cylinders with a dark colored band. If the gate mark is changed, they will be MarkSetBots with no distinguishing banding.

10.3 A race committee starting or finishing vessel may set a stand-off buoy. When present, this stand-off buoy, the line attaching it to the race committee vessel, and the race committee vessel are all part of the starting or finishing mark.

### SI 12 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE is replaced with:

12.1 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will lay a new mark (or move the finishing line) and remove the original mark as soon as practicable. When in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark.

12.2 If there is a change in the location of the weather mark, there will not be an offset mark.

12.3 A change in course to the weather mark *may* be signaled from the Race Committee signal vessel.

### SI 13.1 THE FINISH is replaced with:

13.1 The finishing line will be between a staff or halyard displaying an orange flag on the race committee finishing vessel and the course side of the finishing mark (changing RRS “International Signal Flags”). For all courses, the finish line will be on the same side as the starting line.
