ABBREVIATIONS

[DP] Rules for which the penalties are at the discretion of the protest committee.[NP] Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendices T and V1 shall apply.
- 1.3 **[NP]** Crew substitutions or changes shall be recorded online prior to the start of racing each day.
- 1.4 **[DP]** Boats shall not fly drones while racing or in the racing area.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on or before 1800 on August 4, 2023 on the official notice board at <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=16170</u>.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=16170</u>.
- 3.2 **[DP]** All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on US Marine Frequencies.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4 **[DP]** While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 For the Sonar and Tom 28s classes: skippers shall be CYC members chartering club owned boats.
- 4.2 For the Etchells, J/70, and Shields classes are open to all boats of those classes.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee, at https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=16170.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees is \$75.
- 5.2 An administrative fee of \$15 will apply to cancellations.
- 5.3 There will be no refunds after July 30, 2023.
- 5.4 CYC Sonar Charter fee is \$220 and available on a first come, first serve basis here: https://cyc.rechub.net/event/1655. 8 boats will be available.
- 5.5 Tom28 Charters are subject to availability after season charterers' right of first refusal. Contact Mike DiPlacido to check availability.



6 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Racing will be held on August 5 and 6, 2023.
- 7.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of each day is 1055.
- 7.3 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after approximately 1600.

8 VENUE

Racing will be held in the open waters of Lake Michigan East of Belmont Harbor.

9 COURSES

9.1 The courses to be sailed are windward/leeward courses around inflatable drop or robotic marks.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low Point Scoring.
- 10.2 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 10.3 A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races if four (4) or fewer races have been completed.
- 10.4 A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores excluding her worst score if five (5) or more races have been completed.

11 BERTHING

[DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the harbor.

12 RISK STATEMENT

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 PRIZES

- 13.1 Prizes will be awarded by section for the top three finishers in each class.
- 13.2 The Red Horse Trophy will be awarded to the inshore boat whose section featured the closest, most competitive racing through the regatta as determined at the discretion of the Red Horse Committee.

14 PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RIGHTS

Competitors give absolute right and permission for any photographs or video footage taken of themselves or their competing boat to be published in any media whatsoever for editorial, commercial purposes, or to be used in press information.
