# **EVENT TITLE:**

Add: Tripp 26 Great Lakes Championship – July 22, 23, 24, 2016

## 2. ELIGIBILITY:

Delete: The Regatta will also have Pursuit class(es) with a minimum of two (2) boats required.

Replace with: The Regatta will also have PHRF Spinnaker and Main & Jib classes with a minimum of five (5) boats required in each class.

## **3. SCHEDULE:**

Delete and replace with:

- Registration is from 1600 to 2100 hours on Thursday, July 21, 1500 to 2200 hours on Friday, July 22 and from 0800 to 0900 hours on Saturday, July 23.
- Racing for the Tripp 26 and J70 Great Lakes Championship competitors will be on Friday, July 22, Saturday, July 23 and Sunday, July 24
- Racing for all other classes on designated course areas on Saturday, July 23 and Sunday, July 24.
- The first warning signal will be 1000 hours each racing day.
- It is the intent of the Organizing Authority and the Race Committee to run as many races as practical on each day of racing up to a maximum of eight (8) races for the event, except the Tripp 26 and J70 Classes which will have a maximum of twelve (12) races for the event. No starting sequence will commence after 1400 hours on Sunday, July 24.
- Awards presented at approximately 1600 hours on July 24, or as soon as possible following racing.

#### **5. FEES:**

Remove:

• Cancellations after July 22nd are non-refundable for one-design and pursuit classes and after July 21st for J70 Great Lakes Championship competitors.

Replace with:

• Cancellations after July 22nd are non-refundable for one-design and pursuit classes and after July 21st for Tripp 26 and J70 Great Lakes Championship competitors.

# 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Remove:

The pursuit class(es) will have separate SI's, differing from the one-design classes.

#### 8. COURSES:

Remove:

Courses for pursuit class(es) will be announced at the skipper's meeting on Saturday, July 23.

## 9. SCORING:

Remove:

The pursuit class(es) will have separate scoring each day. The pursuit classes will use the PHRF handicap rating for starting sequence, but are scored using the low-point scoring system.

Replace with:

The handicap scoring for PHRF Spinnaker and Main & Jib classes will be determined using PHRF-LO Time on Time (TOT).

# 13. PRIZES:

Remove:

The overall scoring includes one-design classes and pursuit classes.

Replace with:

The overall scoring includes one-design classes and PHRF classes.
