Sailing Instructions (SIs) ADDENDUM B

This Addendum B is published and applies only to races held 9/18/24 and 9/25/24 that are hosted by CYC. This Addendum is added to the original SIs and Addendum A. If there is a conflict between documents, Addendum B shall apply.

ABBREVIATIONS

[DP] Rules for which the penalties are at the discretion of the protest committee.

[NP] Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a)

1 SCHEDULE OF RACES

The first warning signal will be at 1830 for all races between 9/18/2024 and 9/25/2024.

1.1 All boats registered in the Chicago Beer Can Series Regatta will be eligible to race. There are no additional fees required and no additional registration required.

2 CLASS FLAGS & SECTIONS

For these three races we are combining the 8 sections from Columbia into four sections as follows

Code flags are encouraged to be flown but not required



3 COURSES

3.1 No later than the warning signal, the race committee signal vessel will display the course number. If Course 2 is displayed, it will include the approximate compass bearing and distance of the drop mark. **[NP]** Course information may also be signaled by courtesy broadcast on the designated VHF Channel.

3.2 COURSE 1

4 START

- 4.1 Races will be started using RRS 26.
- 4.2 The Start for both courses will be the orange flag on the signal boat and Chicago Harbor Outer Breakwater South End Light. The chart below shows the approximate location of the race committee. The race committee may or may not move for the finishes.
- 4.3 The Starting Sequence will be:
 - Green/JAM
 - 2. Spin 3 & 4
 - 3. J105 & 36.7
 - 4. Spin 1 & 2
- 4.4 The race committee may combine classes for a start by displaying both class flags at the warning.
- 4.5 The race committee may omit starts with no competitors.

5 FINISH

- 5.1 The Finish for both courses will be between the blue flag on the signal boat and the Chicago Harbor Outer Breakwater South End Light.
- 5.2 Boats approaching the Finishing area shall illuminate their sail numbers on their Main sail or display number board so they can be identified after dusk. Failure to do so may result in a score of DNF without a hearing if a boat cannot be identified. *This changes rules 35, 63.1, A4, and A5.*
- 5.3 Boats shall monitor channel 69 as they finish in case the RC needs help in identifying boats.



18. SCORING

- 18.1 These three races are not part of Columbia's Chicago Beer Can Series and will not count toward that series score. They are part of the CYC Skyline Series and will count toward that series score.
- 18.2 These races will be individually scored, and prizes awarded.

21. PRIZES

- 21.1 Social: There will be an after party at CYC Monroe station following each race. Non-member boats are welcome to dock or raft off at the club during the parties. There will be a prize awarded to the first finishing boat in each section that is present at the party. You must be there to win. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the committee. Awards will be handed out approximately one hour after the finish of the race.
- 21.2 There will be a buffet dinner (\$16), Mount Gay pours (\$6) Beer special (\$3) along with full bar service. Racers (members & non-members) are welcome in the bar and patio. Non-members can use credit cards.
