SI Amendment #2, issued 7/26/2024

Section 9 Marks, is changed to the following

(this replaces the original SI and amendment #1):

9. Marks.

- 9.1 The starting mark will be an orange ball. When finishing downwind, the finish mark will be the same as the starting mark.
- 9.2 The windward mark and the leeward gate marks will be orange inflatable tetrahedrons and will be rounded as shown in the course diagrams. The colors used in the course diagrams are for illustrative purposes only and may not reflect colors described in this section.
- 9.3 If an offset is used, it will be a small orange ball.
- 9.4 In case of a change of course, the new mark will be a large orange ball.
- 9.5 If only one leeward gate mark is present, it shall be rounded to port.

Section 10.3 is changed to the following:

- 10.3 In addition to the prescriptions of RRS 29 for individual recalls, the Race Committee will attempt to hail boats identified as On the Course Side (OCS) by verbal hails or by VHF radio. The failure to hail, the hail of some but not all boats, untimely hail of a boat or boats shall not be grounds for granting redress (changes RRS 62.1 (a)).
