**Equipment:** In addition to the class required equipment: A yacht must carry ground tackle of not less than 15-pound anchor or equivalent in manufacturer's rating and 50 ft. of 5/16 inch manila anchor line, or 1/4-inch minimum diameter synthetic anchor line or better, and an oar (paddle). Wearable life jackets are required. Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 72.

competitors. The J.W. Hurst perpetual trophy will be awarded to the highest placing novice. Novice is defined as a competitor that has not won a CBYRA sanctioned event in the Hampton Class. The Regatta Chairman will post a list of eligible competitors for the Hurst Trophy prior to the first race. The William J. Daugherty Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best crew of the year. The T. Lane Stokes Cup will be awarded to the Hampton One Design sailor (skipper or crew) who: exhibits exemplary sportsmanship, actively participates in Hampton One Design regattas, and actively promotes the Hampton One Design Class. The Charles H. McCoy, Jr. Hampton One Design High Point Trophy will be awarded to the skipper with the most points as outlined in the Sea Chest document.
