- 2.1 This event is open to all monohulls with a valid PHRF Eastern Connecticut certificate on file at ecsa.net and One Design classes recognized by NBYC.
 - 2.2 Participants may register for spinnaker or non-spinnaker classes and party tickets online at www.nbyc.org, then follow link to <u>yachtscoring.com</u>.
- 2.3 Entry forms for snail mail are available on the web site and should be sent with payment to John Bourget at NBYC, Niantic, CT.
- 2.4 Entry Deadline is Friday, June 3rd at 1800.

3. FEES

- 3.1 The Entry Fee is \$40 per boat for US Sailing members. \$45 for non-members.
 - 3.2 Party tickets are \$10 per ticket.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 First warning is scheduled at 1100 on Sunday, June 5, 2016.
 - 4.2 Sailing Instructions will be available online at www.nbyc.org on June 1, 2016.
 - 4.3 The unofficial Scratch Sheet will be actively building on line during registration and will be finalized by the Race Committee on Saturday, June 4th by 1800.
 - 4.3 Multiple races are planned for all classes at the discretion of the Race Committee.

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1 The Race Committee will assign ratings and classes.

6. VENUE

6.1 Racing will take place in Niantic Bay and Fishers Island Sound.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 The courses will be selected by the Race Committee based on weather conditions. The marks will be identified in the Sailing Instructions and will be a combination of government marks and drop marks.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Time on Time calculation will be used to score the PHRF classes.
- 8.2 There will be no throw outs. This changes *RRS Appendix A2*.
