Management: North Star Sail Club is the organizing authority and will provide race management.

Eligibility: Races are open to sail yachts owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations which are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees. In the event that the registered skipper is unable to be on board, he/she is allowed to have a duly insured alternate skipper to represent him/her in up to two (2) races.

Registration: Registration shall be submitted according to registration instructions on the NSSC web site (NorthStarSail.org/Racing). Completed entry forms shall be received by 1200 on the day prior to the event. Late entries will be accepted and will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

Classes: JAM, Asymmetrical, and Spinnaker classes. Class splits will be posted at NSSC clubhouse no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats are required for a class.

Schedule: Spring Series: May 6, 13, 20, 27, June 10, 17; Summer Series: July 29, August 5, 19, 26, September 9, 16. The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1900.

Ratings: If a boat does not have a current DRYA rating certificate, the RC will assign a temporary rating as described in the ABYRA Handbook.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be available at NSSC and on the NSSC web site (NorthStarSail.org/Racing) no later than one week prior to the event. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at NSSC by 1700 on the day of the race. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the official notice board for notices.

Course: The course will be on Anchor Bay. Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to the warning signal. Available course configurations and visual signals are described in the ABYRA Handbook.

Scoring: Races will be scored using order of finish for one-design classes and time-on-time over PHRF for other classes and division overall. See ABYRA Handbook for series scoring rules.

Awards: Results available at NSSC after each race. Spring awards presented July 29 after the race. Summer and Season awards will be presented at the ABYRA Haul Out Party & Awards Banquet.

Race Committee Duty: All registered boats are responsible for 1 (one) race committee duty per the rules described in the ABYRA Handbook.
