NOR Amendment #1

Section 2.2 should read as follows:

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to all boats of the International 420 class.
- 2.2. All sailors must be either current members of US Sailing (www.ussailing.org) and the US I-420 Class Association (www.usi420.org), or for non-US residents, members of their own National Governing Body.

Section 9.1 should read as follows:

9. SAFETY

- 9.1. Competitors shall wear at all times while afloat, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing, a properly secured personal floatation device. U.S. Competitors shall wear USCG approved Type III PFDs. Competitors from outside the U.S. shall wear either a PFD approved by their nations' certification authority or a USCG approved PFD.
- 9.2. Failure to comply with 9.1 will be grounds for penalty, at the discretion of the protest committee, up to disqualification from any or all races sailed on the day of the violation instructions.
- 9.3. Competitors shall supply the equipment to meet the requirements of 9.1.
- 9.4. An adult (Parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of the each sailor. It is the responsibility of this adult to decide if the sailor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. In addition, the Race Committee may require a competitor to retire from racing if the competitor is determined to be a risk to their own or others' safety.
