Eligibility: All boats must be over 20 feet LOA. Classes expected include <u>PHRF A, B, C,</u> <u>NS (double headsail allowed)</u>, <u>One-Design classes to include Viper 640, J70</u>, <u>J24. The regatta also will serve as the *Viper Atlantic Coast Championships*. <u>Also expected are Cruising and Multihull fleets</u>.</u>

> PHRF, Cruising and Multihull fleet boats must meet category *ChesBay* of the PHRF of the Chesapeake Safety Equipment Requirements. All PHRF fleet competitors must have a current, valid PHRF of the Chesapeake rating certificate. Multihull boats must have a current, valid Chesapeake Multihull Association rating.

> <u>One Design classes</u> and Multihull Division boats must have **at least five (5)** entered and paid by May 20th.

Races: Racing for PHRF, One Design, Cruising and Multihull Divisions:

PHRF DIVISION: Racing Friday and Sunday will be windward/leeward courses in the harbor.

- Multiple weather marks and gates
- Non-Spin may use double-headsails
- Goal is an 8 race series

Saturday will be a Distance Race in the Bay starting off Buckroe and finishing at Fort Monroe.

- Unique course with multiple options to shorten
- Finish at Fort Monroe seawall

ONE DESIGN DIVISION: All racing will be windward/leeward courses in the harbor.

- Courses will include off set marks and gates
- Short courses with several races run each day
- Goal is an 11 race series
- Five (5) boats required for a separate class start.
 OD Class must be "made" (entered and paid) by May 20th

CRUISING & MULTIHULL DIVISIONS: Race Saturday and Sunday <u>only</u>.

- Saturday will be a Distance Race in the Bay
- Sunday will be a random leg race in the Bay off Ocean View

All racing begins at 10:00am each day.

The Low Point Scoring System will be used; 1 throw-out if at least 5 races completed.
