

AMENDMENT #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS for both Fixed and Drop Marks Courses

Explanation: Due to the small number of entries, the race committee is consolidating the fixed marks and drop marks racers to share a common signal boat, the race committee intends to start the Fixed Marks classes as originally scheduled, and then, from the same race committee signal vessel, run multiple races for the Drop Marks classes.

The signal boat will be starting on one side of the boat (orange flag) and finishing on the other side of the boat (blue flag).

For the Drop Marks Course:

SI 5.1, Schedule, is replaced with:

5.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the day is **1130**.

SI 8.2, Courses, is replaced with:

8.2 The race committee starting vessel will be located in the vicinity of R"2".

SI 19.1, Prizes, is replaced with:

19.1 First, second, and third place awards will be presented for the J22 and J105 classes (having had 5 entries per NoR 2.5).

For the Fixed Marks Course:

SI 2.2, Communications with Competitors, is replaced with:

2.2 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors via VHF radio on **channel 72**.

SI 5.1, Schedule, is replaced with:

SI 13, The Finish, is replaced with:

The finishing line will be between a staff or halyard displaying a **BLUE** flag on the race committee finishing vessel and the course side of R"2". Note that the finishing vessel might not be the starting signal vessel.

SI 19.1, Prizes, is replaced with:

19.1 First, second, and third place awards will be presented for the A2 class (having had 5 entries per NoR 2.5).
