NOTICE OF RACE

Amendment #1

Add a new class: the Club class:

- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY is replaced with
- 2.1 The race is open to boats:
 - a. holding current IRC certificates or current YRA of LIS PHRF certificates. Doublehanded, non-spinnaker, and one-design classes will be established if enough entries are received.

Each boat in these classes must hold a 2017 rating certificate, and the person in charge shall assure her rating on YachtScoring.com is valid at the time of entry. Ratings must be verifiable on ircrating.org for IRC boats, and yralis.org for PHRF boats. For PHRF boats the rating shall be their distance race rating, and for double-handed PHRF boats the rating shall be from their double-handed certificate.

- b. without a current or valid certificate, who will race in the Club class. Boats in this class will be assigned a PHRF rating by the race committee which will be valid for this race only. The Club class is non-spinnaker.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering online at: http://www.yachtscoring.com/event_registration_email.cfm?eid=3041, by Wednesday, May 10, 2017. Late entries will be accepted until 1600 Friday, May 12, 2017.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$100.00. For entries received after the May 10 deadline, the entry fee is \$125.00. The entry fee includes Sailors' Welcome and Awards Presentation for skippers and crews featuring complimentary hot dogs, chili, beer, dark 'n' stormies, and live music.

7 SCORING

7.2 is changed to:

For PHRF-rated boats and the Club class, time allowances will be computed using time on distance

8 PRIZES

8.1 is changed to:

Awards will include perpetual trophies and prizes for first, second and third place in each class with seven or more entries; first and second with five or more entries, and first with three or more entries.

Add:

8.4 For the Larchmont Yacht Club Cruising Squadron boats racing in PHRF or the Club class, this race counts toward the Glover-Johnson trophy.
