NOTICE OF RACE (12/14/09)

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The following rules are changed by this NOR: Rule 44.1 - Two-Turns Penalty, see NOR 9; Appendix A2 - Scoring, see NOR 11. Other rules may be changed by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be pursuant to ISAF Regulation 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to all members of the International A-Class Catamaran Association (IACA) or any of its recognized national asso-
- 3.2 Entries shall be made by submitting a completed Entry Form application or via online registration. Entry Forms may be found at www.ncyc.net.

4. FEES

Registration Fee: \$250 (if received by July 31,2010; \$275 thereafter)

6. MEASUREMENT and CERTIFICATES

It is the competitor's responsibility to see that the boat, its spars, sails and equipment comply with the class rules. Please refer to "ISAF International A-Class Catamaran Equipment Inspection Regulations" available at www.ncyc.net.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in and registration. In the event of a conflict between this NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the SIs shall prevail.

8. RACING VENUE

The Regatta will be sailed in open waters of Lake Erie, East of North Cape Yacht Club.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 (Penalties at the Time of an Incident) will be changed so a one turn penalty shall be required for a breach of Part 2 rules.

10. BOAT STORAGE and LAUNCHING

Boats will sail off the beach at NCYC. Trailers will be stored on the beach or grounds of NCYC at the direction of the Beach Captain.

11. SCORING

The Low Point System of RRS A4 will be used. Four races must be completed to constitute a series. RRS A2 is modified as follows: If six to nine races are completed there will be one throw-out and if more than nine races are completed there will be two throw-outs.

12. INSURANCE

All participants must have a valid liability insurance policy for a minimum of \$300,000 liability protection. A copy of certificate of insurance is required from each participant upon check-in.

13. PRIZES

Individual trophies for 1st through at least 5th place; 1st Master (ages 50-59 inclusive) and 1st Grand Master (age 60+). Ages for Master and Grand Master as of Sept. 10, 2010
